Next weekend verily is a special time for all of us "to give ${f PASTOR'S}$ ${f DESK}$ thanks" for so many blessings that we experience in our daily lives

in Canada. Please let us not take our 'blessings' for granted. Let **Thanksgiving** weekend be a precious time for 'giving thanks'.

Let us warmly develop an "Attitude of Gratitude"! What a great difference this will make!

And speaking of Gratitude, we, as a parish, truly must express our warmest Thank You to a faithful parishioner +Walter Lukey who was called recently into the Heavenly Kingdom. He kindly chose in his Last Will & Testament to appoint St. Mary's as a special beneficiary of his Estate. Walter was most grateful for his active participation in this worshipping community and therefore, gifted the parish with a generous donation, knowing that we, in turn, will use these funds to help others and that we will pray daily for him - as we pray for all our benefactors and parishioners.

It has always deeply disturbed me, wherever I have served as Pastor, to discover that so many of our Ukrainian citizens do not have a Last Will and Testament. Apparently in Canada this figure is frighteningly near 50%. It's almost as if we have slowly convinced ourselves that if we don't make a Will, then we will not die! The reality is, I, as your Pastor am preparing for this final day and so must YOU!

You have worked so very hard to provide for yourself and your family and it only makes good sense that YOU choose what happens to your inheritance. Without a Will and Last Testament, our government will gladly dispose of your hard-earned savings (or lawyers will have to choose for you!)

One of the great joys of writing a Last Will is that YOU personally choose to whom you offer your riches and your possessions (no matter how large or small!). We all have heard horror stories of families destroying themselves by actually fighting over the deceased "possessions" after a funeral. What a sad and pitiful sight – and this is the result of people not taking time to make these important decisions during their life time.

Following +Walter Lukey's good example, we strongly encourage all Catholics, all parishioners, to also consider making provision in your Will for the continuing financial support of St. Mary's Parish. This is a wonderful way to, not only thank God for the blessings that we have received, but also to ensure our church is able to meet the needs of future generations. A Gift that 'Keeps on Giving..." is a living testimony of your generosity!


His intention for evangelization is: "That with a missionary spirit the Christian communities of Asia may announce the Gospel to those who are still awaiting it".
