Beloved Parishioners and Guests,

Slava Isusu Khrystu!

A man came home from work, tired and irritated to find his 10 year old son waiting for him at the door. "May I ask you a guestion?" said the son. "Sure, what is it?" said the father. "Daddy, how much do you make an hour?" And the father answered that he makes \$50 an hour. Later the son came to his father and PASTOR'S DESK asked if he could borrow \$25. The father was furious. "If the only PASTOR'S DESK reason you asked is so that you can buy a silly toy then go



straight to your room and leave me alone." The boy quietly went to his room and shut the door. After an hour or so the father started thinking that perhaps the child really needed something and went to the boy's room for a talk.

The father said: "Maybe I spoke too harshly. Here's the \$25 that you asked for." "O thank you" cried the boy, and then reached under his pillow and pulled out some crumbled bills. The man saw that the boy already had money and became angry again. And as the boy slowly counted the money his father asked why he wanted money if he already had some. And the boy answered "Because before I didn't have enough and now I do!" At that moment the son extended the entire sum toward his father and said: "Daddy, I have \$50 now! Can I buy an hour of your time?"

What a poignant reminder to each of us. Not everyone has a son...but we all have someone in our lives who sooner or later hungrily awaits our time and maybe would gladly pay \$50 for us to share a kind word with them.

Time has a tendency to fly very quickly. days blend with weeks and weeks with months. And very often he person that we meant to call waits and waits as we keep telling ourselves that we get in touch "tomorrow".

Let us not wait to give our attention to our child, to our parent or to our dear friend but let us share that \$50 hour TODAY. If we should die tomorrow the company that we work for could easily replace us with someone else but those who love us will feel the loss for the rest of their lives! Let us be with them while we still can!

Yes, let us give our loved ones the "gift of our time"...but let us not stop at time alone. Let us give them our full attention and try to see things from their perspective. Let them feel our love and let us tell them and show them that they make a huge difference in our lives.

Let us remember to give our attention to those whom we love and may I suggest that we not forget the **One** who deserves it most! Let us faithfully turn to our Lord God and tell Him that we are very grateful for His many graces and blessings!
