Christ is Risen! Indeed He is Risen!

The celebration of Easter occurs on a different Sunday every year. If you celebrate Easter according the Gregorian calendar, (as does most of the Western world) Easter always falls on the first Sunday after the full moon after the first day of Spring. If you celebrate Easter according to the Julian or Old calendar, as do our sisters and brothers in Ukraine, some Ukrainian parishes here in Canada and in other countries where Ukrainians have emigrated, the date is much more difficult to calculate. Easter sometimes coincides on the same day or is either a week, four weeks or five weeks apart.

Unfortunately, through the years we, Ukrainians, have often paid more attention to WHEN we celebrate Easter or Christmas or any of the other major holy days that to the very reason WHY we are celebrating the feast days in the first place.

Many Canadian-Ukrainians grew up in Eastern Europe and throughout most of their lives have celebrated holy days according to the old Julian calendar but if anyone were to ask me which is the “correct” date of Easter, I would have to say: the correct day is when we accept the presence of Jesus in our lives! THIS is what is important! Easter is when we find hope and joy through Christ in our lives! Yes, the past shapes our thoughts but hope gives us the strength to move ahead, to daily grow. It is the things that we have not yet experienced, not yet explained, not yet resolved, that hopefully challenges us into an unknown future.

And so, this Easter, as we say: “Christ is Risen” and answer: “Indeed He is Risen” let us each arise in hope together with Christ...so that not only Christ is Risen, but that we too, may personally rise!

- Though there is much selfishness in our world, let us rise to generosity.
- Though there is much jealousy in our relationships, let us rise to understanding.
- Though there is often anger all around us, let us rise to serenity.
- Though laziness often overtakes our lives, let us rise to diligence.
- Though pessimism taints our outlook on life, let us rise to optimism.
- Though there is much violence in our communities, let us rise to peace.
- Though conflicts poison our lives, let us rise to harmony.
- Though there is much hatred in this world, let us rise to love.

O God, our true confidence and our lasting hope, help us to lovingly know You and to generously live by your Spirit. We humbly confess our tendency to despair and our temptation to trust only in our personal resources. Help us to open ourselves graciously to the limitless resources of the Resurrection, so that we also may be dreamers who will rebuild the world to come, thus joining with You in makin your creation whole-some and new. Please grant that we, who joyously celebrate Christ’s resurrection from the dead, may resurrect from the stagnation of hopelessness to the life-giving power of Hope itself. Amen.

May you have a wonderful, joyful and loveful Easter!
May this Easter be a beautiful celebration of Hope and Love for each and every one of you.

Великдень щороку припадає в інший час. Якщо ви святкуєте Великдень зі західним світом, згідно з григоріанським календарем, Великдень завжди припадає на першу неділю після повного місяця, після першого дня весни. Якщо ви святкуєте Великдень згідно з юліанським календарем так, як наші брати і сестри в Україні та декотрі парафії в Канаді та в інших державах, де виємігрували українці, цю дату значно складніше вирахувати. Юліанський Великдень часами припадає на той сам день, як григоріанський а може бути у святкуванні різниця одного тижня, чотирьох або навіть п'ятьох тижнів.

На жаль, українцям часто було важніше КОЛИ ми святкуємо Великдень чи інші великі свята, як ЧОМУ ми їх святкуємо.

Багато канадійських українців виросли в Східній Європі і продовж більшості свого життя святкували свята за юліанським календарем але, як би мене хтось спитав, котра є правильна дата на святкування Великодня, я відповів би, що правильний час святкувати Великдень - це день, коли ми готові прийняти Ісуса у своєму житті. Ось ЦЕ є суттєве! Великдень – це час, коли ми через Христа знаходимо надію і радість в житті. Минуле формує нам думки але надія дає нам силу дивитися вперед та рости і розвиватися. Це, що ми ще не пережили, це, що ми ще не вияснили, це, що ми ще не вирішили – ось надія дає нам силу братися за незнане майбутнє.

Отож, коли ми цього Великодня кажемо «Христос Воскрес» та відповідаємо «Воістину Воскрес», воскресаймо в надії разом з Христом... щоб не лиш Христос воскрес але, щоб ми також воскресли:

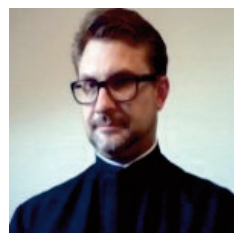


YEAR OF MERCY ON DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

**EASTER GREETINGS TO THE FAITHFUL OF THE EPARCHY OF SASKATOON
ON THE OCCASION OF THE RESURRECTION OF OUR LORD, 2016**

To the Very Reverend Clergy, Monastics and Religious, Seminarians and Laity of the Eparchy of Saskatoon:

Christ Is Risen! Indeed He is Risen! Христос Воскрес! Воістину Воскрес!

“Jesus is risen from the tomb, as He foretold, and granted us everlasting life and great mercy.”
(Paschal Matins).

Many times in scripture Jesus restores human dignity to those who have been judged. Regardless of their sinfulness, Jesus gives people hope in life, hope in Jesus, hope in the Kingdom of God, hope in the resurrection. This is how we sample the resurrection in everyday life, one moment at a time. This is how we are invited to experience Jesus our Pasch, receiving it and sharing it with others.

In Chapter 7 of the Gospel of Luke Jesus dines with a Pharisee named Simon yet it is a repentant woman that washes his feet with her tears and dries them with her hair only to anoint them in the end. Here, we have a powerful example of God’s great mercy. “Therefore I tell you, her sins, which are many, are forgiven—for she loved much. But he who is forgiven little, loves little.”

So as not to dilute the Holy Father’s words, I quote his homily at the outset of the Holy Year:

This Extraordinary Holy Year is itself a gift of grace. To pass through the Holy Door means to rediscover the infinite mercy of the Father who welcomes everyone and goes out personally to encounter each of them. This will be a year in which we *grow ever more convinced of God’s mercy*. How much wrong we do to God and his grace when we speak of sins being punished by his judgment before we speak of their being forgiven by his mercy (cf. Saint Augustine, *De Praedestinatione Sanctorum*, 12, 24)! But that is the truth. We have to put mercy before judgment, and in any event God’s judgment will always be in the light of his mercy. In passing through the Holy Door, then, may we feel that *we ourselves are part of this mystery of love*. Let us set aside all fear and dread, for these do not befit men and women who are loved. Instead, let us experience *the joy of encountering that grace which transforms all things*.

May you encounter the living Christ in your community, your vibrant parish, your Branch, your Council and in your home. Enter into the mystery of His mercy. Then be that mercy for others, inviting people to encounter Christ. The blessings of the Risen Lord be with you and your family, as your voice and actions proclaim –

Христос Воскрес! Воістину Воскрес! Christ Is Risen! Indeed He Is Risen!
