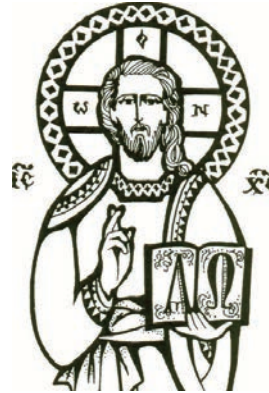

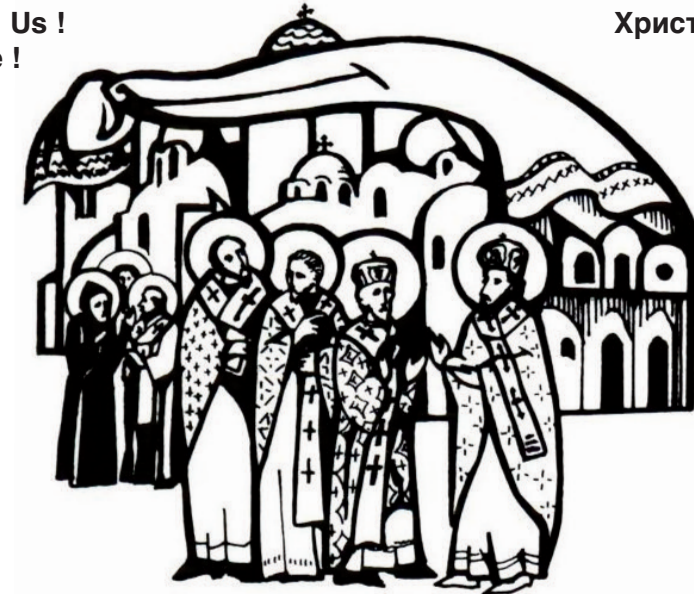

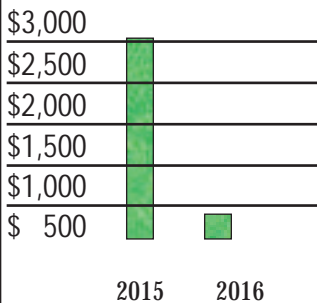

Between 1914 and 1920, about 80,000 Ukrainian immigrants were forced to register as enemy aliens, report regularly to the police and carry identity papers at all times. Over 5,000 were imprisoned in 24 camps where the conditions were grim. Some died, many were sick or injured and several were killed by guards while trying to escape.

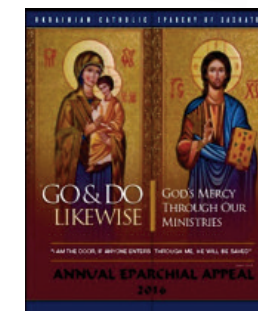

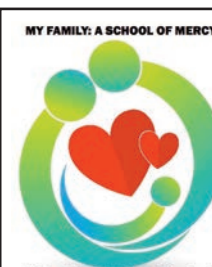

Eparchy of Saskatoon Family and Life Office Bulletin: Mothers Day May 8, 2016

"The future of the world passes through the family"

Familiaris Consortio, 79

The Synod on the Family 2015 has culminated with the recently promulgated Apostolic Exhortation of Pope Francis called *Amoris Laetitia/ Joy of Love*(AL). In this very rich teaching the Holy Father reflects deeply on the role, challenges and gifts of Motherhood. To celebrate Mothers and begin the National Week for Life and Family (May 8-15th) we offer you this reflection:

Pope Francis' *Amoris Laetitia/The Joy of Love*(AL) on Motherhood:

1. It is just plain smart to honor your mother—we are told in scripture "...whoever glorifies his mother is like one who lays up treasure." (Sir. 3:4) This is not just something we are to do based on 'religious pretense', but as an honest and wholehearted recognition of gratitude for the one who chose to love us into life (AL 17).
2. Motherhood is not just a biological reality but also a 'spiritual reality' that extends to those women who give foster care, have adoptive children or care for 'spiritual children'. All women participate in motherhood through the gift of their 'feminine genius' (AL 173,178).
3. "Mothers are the strongest antidote to the spread of self-centered individualism.... It is they who testify to the beauty of life" (AL 174).
4. Not every child is conceived in ideal circumstances, yet mothers choose to accept the new life within them as a gift from God despite the hardships they might face (AL 170,252).
5. The tenderness of a mother is an icon of God. (Jn. 15:13) A mother, more often than not, chooses to love more than to be loved (AL 27,28,102).
6. A Mother's tender love, in turn, can instill in her children the capacity for intimacy, compassion and empathy (AL 28,175).
7. The work of a mother, inside and outside the home, is a great blessing for her family as we read in Proverbs 31:10-31(AL 24).
8. Mothers are all called to be joyful, not just for themselves but also for the sake of their families (AL 171).
9. By engaging in the great work of 'passing on the faith' a mother forges a bond with her children that goes even deeper than familial bonds; she participates in "sacred birthing" presenting her children for the sacraments, as she recognizes that the ultimate goal of all human life is to participate in the joy of "life eternal" (AL 18, 287, 166).
10. A mother's prayers for her children are powerful, especially when a mother fully accepts her child as a unique person beloved by God and relentlessly offers up her child in prayer, that 'God's will' may be done in her child's life (AL 288).

Thanks Mom!



Mothers often communicate the deepest meaning of religious practice in the first prayers and acts of devotion that their children learn...without mothers not only would there be no new faithful, but the faith itself would lose a good part of its simple and profound warmth...

Dear mothers: thank you! Thank you for what you are in your family and for what you give to the Church and the world. (AL 174)

A Prayer of Blessing for all Mothers:

For those yet to become mothers we pray for open and expectant hearts. We pray that all women open their hearts to the love of the Holy Trinity and are able to trust in God who is the source of all love and life. We pray especially for those who struggle with the idea of motherhood, as they recognize the profound sacrifice involved in cooperating with God to give life. May they have the courage and serenity to choose to be open to a true love that is life giving and never give in to the temptation to destroy life. Lord have mercy.

Also we remember those who, for a multitude of reasons, may never become biological mothers but are true mothers just the same. May they always be open to giving of themselves and nurturing life, particularly imparting the faith to their children. Let us remember in a special way those who give of themselves, for the sake of the Kingdom, in religious life. Bless all these mothers for the great gifts they give the Church and the world. Lord have mercy.

For all those who are currently performing the great work of motherhood—we pray for your faith, courage, acceptance, perseverance and above all for JOY! "Don't let fears, worries, other people's comments or problems lessen your joy at being God's means of bringing a new life to the world." (AL 171) Forgive our mothers for all of their sins. Help us to forgive them and to focus on their love, despite their weaknesses and imperfections. Help all mothers to receive Your grace and mercy and be channels of love and mercy for others. Lord have mercy.

For all our mothers who have passed on to eternal life we pray for their eternal peace in the place where the "sound of those celebrating never ceases." We pray that someday we will be reunited with our mother or grandmother in the place where there is "...no more mourning, and crying and pain will be no more." (Rev. 21:4) Dear Mom, please pray for us as we know that "The better we live on this earth, the greater the happiness we will be able to share with our loved ones in heaven. The more we are able to mature and develop in this world, the more gifts we will be able to bring to the heavenly banquet." (AL 258) Lord have mercy.
