Glory be to Jesus Christ!

I have another delightful story to share with you...

Charles Plumb, a US Navel Academy graduate, was a jet pilot in Vietnam. After 75 combat missions, his plane was destroyed by a missile and Plumb parachuted into enemy lands. He was captured and spent 6 years in a communist Vietnamese prison. He survived the ordeal and now lectured on lessons he learned from that experience.

One day when Plumb and his wife were sitting in a restaurant, a man at another table came up and said "You're Plumb! You flew jet fighters in Vietnam from the aircraft carrier Kitty Hawk. You were shot down!" "How in the world did you know that?" asked Plumb. "I packed your parachute," replied the man. Plumb gasped in surprise and gratitude. The man shook his hand and said "I guess it worked?" Plumb assured him, "If your parachute had not worked I would not be here today."

Plumb couldn't sleep that night, thinking about that man. Plumb says ; "I kept wondering what he might have looked like when he was younger. I wonder how many times I might have seen him and not even said 'good morning' or how are you or anything because, you see, I was a fighter pilot and he was just a sailor." Plumb thought of the many hours the sailor had spent on a long wooden table in the bowels of the ship, carefully weaving ropes and folding the silks of each chute, holding in his hands the fate of someone he did not know.

When Plumb told his story, he explained that there were many **different kinds of parachutes** that he needed when his jet was shot down over enemy territory – he needed his **physical** parachute, his **mental** parachute, his **emotional** parachute and his **spiritual** one. He called on all of these supports before reaching safety. And someone at some time packed each of the parachutes that he needed. So Plumb asks all of us: **"Who has packed your parachute?"** To whom are you grateful for providing what you need to survive in life?

How often we get caught up in our own importance and forget the vital role so many people play in our lives. None of us ever packs all of our own parachutes. Many different people do this for us throughout all of our lives. But what is essential to know and to always remember is that it is *not only* our parachute that needs proper packing. The world also awaits **our role** as the "packers" of parachutes.

Parents prepare their children for the safe "flight of life" by packing solid Christian principles into their upbringing. **Teachers** pack their student's parachutes with positive knowledge and a love for learning. **I, your priest,** must pack your parachute in such a way that someday you, *my dear parishioners,* will have something to hold on to. Every profession is yet another parachute for someone to someday use.

I urge you to consider the **huge responsibility** that each of us has toward our fellow man and the power that we each have to affect the people in our lives, whether we know them or not. May we approach this responsibility with love and thoughtfulness – with the love of Christ and one another!

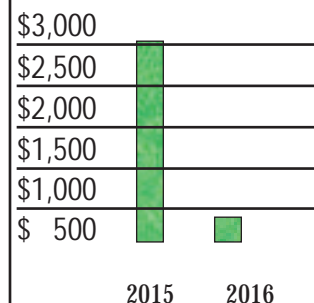

Слава Ісусу Христу!

Знов хочу з вами поділитися гарною розповіддю...

Чарльз Плам, випускник американської військово-морської академії, був пілотом реактивного літака у В'єтнамі. Після 75-ти бойових вильотів ракета підбила його літак і Плама викинуло з літака і він опинився на ворожій території, де він потрапив у полон та відсидів 6 років у комуністичній в'єтнамській в'язниці. Він пережив це випробування і тепер читає лекції в університеті на тему всього, що він пережив і навчився.

Одного разу, коли Плам з дружиною сиділи в ресторані, чоловік зі сусіднього столика підійшов до нього і сказав: «Ви є Плам! Ви літали реактивними винищувачами у В'єтнамі з авіаносця «Kitty Hawk» і Вас збили!» «Як Ти знаєш про це?» спитав Плам. «Бо я є той, який укладав Ваш парашут» відповів чоловік. Плам зі здивування та з вдячності аж задихнувся. Чоловік подав йому руку і сказав: «Виглядає, що я правильно Ваш парашут уклад!» Плам запевнив його: «Якби цей парашут не був би правильно зложений, мене би тут сьогодні не було.»

Плам тої ночі не міг заснути і весь час думав про цього чоловіка. «Я пробував собі нагадати, як він в молодості виглядав. Я застановлявся над тим, скільки разів я мусів був з ним зустрічатися і навіть не звертав на нього уваги і не спитав, як він себе почуває. Зрозумійте, що я був пілотом винищувача, а він простий моряк.» Плам почав роздумувати над тим, що цей моряк просидів багато годин за довгим дерев'яним столом внутрі корабля та обережно сплітав шнури та складав шовкові тканини парашута, тримаючи в своїх руках долю невідомої йому людини.

Коли Плам переповідав цю історію, він пояснював, що тоді, коли його літак був збитий над ворожою територією, йому потрібно було різних парашутів, щоб вижити: **фізичного** парашута, **ментального**, **емоційного** та **духовного**. Поки він безпечно спустився на землю, він мусів триматися кожного із них, а кожного із них хтось, дець, колись обережно склав, щоб він міг їх триматися, коли йому було цього потрібно. І Плам звертається до кожного з нас з питанням: **«Хто спакував Тобі Твій парашут?» Кому Тобі треба бути вдячним за все, що Тобі потрібне в житті, щоб вижити?**

Як часто нам здається, що ми є дуже важними і ми забуваємо, яку велику роль інші люди відіграють у нашому житті. Ніхто з нас ніколи не укладає всіх своїх власних парашутів. Впродовж нашого життя багато різних людей нам наші парашути готують. А дуже важливо знати і завжди пам'ятати, що не тільки наші парашути потребують, щоб їх хтось правильно зложив, але світ також на НАШУ роль у складанні парашутів.

Дуже багато із того, що ми в житті робимо, це просто ще одне укладання парашута. **Батьки** підготовляють дітей на безпечний «політ» в житті і укладають свій парашут, даючи їм солідні підстави у їх вихованні. **Учителі** вкладають парашути знання та любов своїх учнів до науки. **Я, ваш священник**, мушу так вкласти Ваш парашут, щоби Ви, мої дорогі парафіяни, мали колись чогось триматися. Кожна професія є просто ще один парашут, з якого колись хтось буде користати.

Я прошу вас застановитися над **великою відповідальністю**, яку ми всі маємо супроти інших людей, і над тим, яку ми маємо силу вплинути на життя людей, яких ми в житті зустрічаємо, навіть якщо ми їх не знаємо. Бажаю вам підходити до цієї відповідальності з чуйністю та любов'ю...

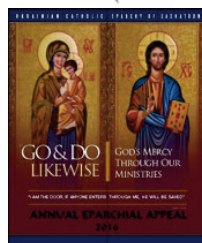
