## Glory be to Jesus Christ! Glory be forever!

Sooner of later, people of all sizes, colours and creeds, be they pious or not, reach out to their Maker. Some pray fervently and often; others pray only in times of crisis! Each and every one of us has our own style and our own depth of prayer, and, of course, every religion encourages different styles of prayer. But no matter what our background may be, our deepest inner feelings and longings are similar: concern for family, assistance in healing, longing for peace PASTOR'S DESK or a wish for greater wisdom.

The **best type of prayer** exists when all selfish desire is put aside, and we feel ourselves in communion with God. At this point, our greatest wish is that God's will be done. Prayer then becomes more than a means to an end, it becomes a state of humility. It can exist whether we are singing in a church choir, washing the floor, or composing a symphony. Prayer is communion with God.

We must remember that *prayer has power!* The power of prayer is the constant renewal of perspective. Prayer opens our eyes. It extends our horizons. It sheds light into the darkness of our fears and our sorrows, our hopes and joys, our shame and our pride. It gives us new ways of seeing life and relationships. The power of prayer is real! You can feel it and know it and depend on it. Although it comes to us as a gift, we need to do our part as well. God calls us to pray, and through our prayer, God empowers us and gives us strength.

I ask you stop for a moment to focus on the prayer that Jesus Himself gave us:

Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be Thy name. Thy kingdom come; Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us, and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil, Amen.

Brief as they are, these words cover every aspect of human life! Nothing is left out. Through this prayer we enter God's presence. Much of the power of this prayer lies in its brevity and simplicity. When we have acted in haste or have offended God, we need to be provided for and protected day by day. Above and beyond that, we need the Holy Spirit to fill our hearts and to change us from our very cores. For this to happen, we must ask, "Thy will be done." And we must mean it!

And so, be we the sportsman who makes a sign of the cross before his game...be we the child who calls upon her quardian angel, as she kneels beside her bed... be we the woman who raises her eyes to the heavens as she stands at the grave of her husband...be we the young man who whispers a thank you as his plane lands safely...or be we one of millions who each in his or her own way stops to connect with his or her Maker...may we all do so reverently and very often!

May your prayers always be a source of the hope, strength, encouragement and charity, which I wish for and every one of you...





## Слава Ісусу Христу!

Вона є для нас подарунком але не без того , щоб ми у ній відгравали власну роль. Бог нас закликає молитися і через нашу молитву дає нам силу.

Я прошу вас на хвилинку застановитися над молитвою, яку Сам Ісус нам дав. От наш, Ти, що єси на небесах, нехай святиться ім'я Твоє, нехай прийде Царство Твоє, нехай буде воля Твоя, як на небі, так і на землі. Хліб наш насушний дай нам сьогодні і прости нам наші провини, як ми прощаємо винуватиям нашим. І не введи нас у спокусу але ізбави нас від лукавого. Амінь.

Хоча яка ця молитва коротка, вона криє всі аспекти життя. Нічого у ній не бракує. Через цю молитву ми єднаємося з Богом. Багато сили цієї молитви полягає на тім, що вона коротка та дуже проста. Коли ми в поспіху вразили Бога, нам треба просити прощення. В хвилинах спокуси нам треба просити, щоб нас з цього випровадити і, щоб нас щодня пильнувати та хоронити. Але понад усе нам треба, щоб Святий Дух наповнив наші серця та щоб нас ґрунтовно змінив. А для цього нам треба щиро просити «Нехай діється воля Твоя».

Отже, чи ми є спортсменом, який хреститься перед якоюсь грою... чи ми є малою дитиною, яка клячить біля ліжка та звертається до свого Ангела Хоронителя... чи ми є жінкою, яка звернула очі до неба біля гробу свого чоловіка... чи ми є тою людиною, яка шопотом подякувала, коли її ліктак щасливо приземлився... хто би ми не були, зупиняймося, щоб з'єднатися зі своїм Створителем... і робім це палко і часто.
