- GOODWILL CEO receives \$2.3 million you donate for free & he sells for profit
- SALVATION ARMY Commissioner is paid \$13,000 96% of donations go to a cause
- CANADIAN LEGION Commander receives \$0.00 salary All donations go to help veterans and their families and youth...
- MAKE A WISH 100% goes to funding special wishes for a dying child...
- RONALD McDONALD HOUSE 100% goes to housing and feeding the families of critically ill children in a nearby hospital




