Dear Parishioners and Guests,

Possibly you may have noticed my absence - as you have discovered, this Pastor slips away for his *"sanity break"* in November... it does shorten the winter slightly and I do appreciate this! And now I am back, rejuvenated, refreshed,

restored, and ready to face whatever you throw at me.... **FROM THE** thank you, Father Ray and Father Methodius for happily **PASTOR'S DESK** covering for me!

An exciting event is taking place on **Sunday**, **November 20**th - and that is YORKTON FESTIVAL OF CULTURES taken I will be there this year. Do take time out and enjoy this delightful festival – only for one day between 11:00 am and 6:00 pm. Please participate and support this unique city event.

On November 15th, the Byzantine Churches, such as us, commence the **'Christmas Fast'**. It is also called the *"Fast of St. Philip"* because it is immediately preceded by the feast of this Apostle (November 14th). This time of expectation and of preparation corresponds to Advent.

Since the **Nativity/Theophany** events hold less importance than **Pascha** – the feast of feasts (the Resurrection), a detailed structure never evolved for the Philippian Fast. Yet this Fast is an ancient practice in preparation for the **In**-*carnation* and **Theophany** (Jordan Feast) of the Lord Jesus Christ. This <u>40 Day</u> <u>Fast</u> can help us to better understand and appreciate all of God's saving plan in history. Theologically then, the birth and the public ministry of Christ are inextricably linked.

On arriving at Bethlehem and the Christmas celebration of our Lord Jesus on December 25th, we thus begin to prepare for the Theophany. We do not stop at the Nativity. In our joy of God's arrival, we press forward and celebrate the Epiphany in which we experience the beginning of Christ's revelation to us of the mysteries of God. Most important of all, this event points out the Mystery of the Trinity, a mystery long hinted at in the Old Testament.

During this Advent season, each of our parish organizations hosts a Christmas gathering to express appreciation and gratitude for all the volunteer hours of dedication and devotion to our parish of St. Mary's and beyond. Truly this is a wonderful time of fellowship - a time to enjoy one another's company and to prepare spiritually as a family our celebration of Christmas!

As your pastor, I personally and warmly thank each and everyone of you for your generosity and your commitment and for your

loving support of us, your priests. God bless you all!





HOLODOMOR MEMORIAL DAY **DIVINE LITURGY & PANAKHYDA** SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 26TH 9:00 AM

In the early 1930s, in the very heart of Europe - in a region considered to be Europe's breadbasket - Stalin's Communist regime committed a horrendous act of genocide against up to 10 million Ukrainians. The government imposed exorbitant grain quotas, in some cases confiscating supplies down to the last seed. The result was the Ukrainian genocide of 1932-33, known in Ukrainian as the Holodomor, or extermination by famine.

Victims and losses:

- At the height of the Holodomor Ukrainian villagers were dying at the rate of 25,000 per day or 1,000 per hour or 17 per minute.

- Children comprised one-third of the Holodomor victims in Ukraine. Large numbers of children were orphaned and became homeless.

• The Ukrainian population was reduced by as much as 25 percent.
