

- З Божою поміччю Ваш парох або його сотрудник зможе Вас відвідати і особисто Вам уділити Боже Благословення та помолитися з Вами і Вашою родиною.

JORDAN FAMILY HOME BLESSING

The "Act of Blessing" can be traced back into Salvation history. The practice of the "head" of the family bestowing a blessing upon his family was once a traditional **Ukrainian** custom.

We strongly encourage the RE-Introduction of this beautiful tradition, especially at the commencement of the New Year. We invite you to take the **Jordan Holy Water** home and when the whole family can gather together (if possible), bless one another and your home for God's blessing and graces.

- 1) Let the children or each person hold a candle.
- 2) With the "head" of the family leading, pray this Blessing Service and proceed throughout the house, blessing with the Holy Water....

And God willing, with time, your priest will visit you to offer the blessing of the Church and to pray with you and your family....
