Christ is born! Let us glorify Him!

It seems that we just celebrated Christmas and here we are, already talking about Great Lent. And as every year we remind you that **Great Lent** is not only a preparation for **Easter**, but a time of rebirth. It is a time for self-examination, a time for prayer, a time for more frequent church attendance and a time for fasting. Lent is a **spiritual journey** and Easter is the destination. It is a journey that each of us must take if we are to celebrate Easter as it is supposed to be.

There are five Sundays that prepare us for **Great Lent**, the first of which is **Zacchaeus Sunday**, which we celebrated today. This Sunday's Gospel reminds us that the desire to see God is the beginning of true change. Zacchaeus went to great trouble to climb a tree to see Jesus. The second is the **Sunday of the Publican and the Pharisee** in which we are called to accept the fact that most of us, like the Publican, have lived lives beneath the standard that God has given us. We are called to repent for it is not empty religious pietism that will save our souls, but humility and deference to God. The third is the **Sunday of the Prodigal Son** in which we are to see ourselves as being far from what God desires of us, as did the prodigal son. We are to return to God in repentance where we are welcomed with open arms. The fourth is the **Sunday of the Last Judgment** where we show our love in deeds toward one another. And we remember that God will judge us all; the cares and concerns of this life are fleeting, but God's judgment is inevitable. And lastly there is **Forgiveness Sunday** during which we focus on Christ's words: **"If you forgive the faults of others, your heavenly Father will forgive you yours. If you do not forgive others, neither will your Father forgive you."** Forgiveness Sunday is the beginning of Great Lent and if we are to begin Lent earnestly we must begin it by forgiving others. Allow us, your church, to help you prepare for Lent so that we can take the journey of Lent together.

The United States has spent four long years on a presidential campaign. We saw people divide into those who strongly believed in one candidate, while others believed in the other candidate. However, finally a majority chose Mr. Trump, the new president who was sworn in on January 20th. But whatever one's convictions or points of view, it would so good if all Americans (*and us Canadians too*) could all unite under one spiritual platform, one basic concept of **HOPE!**

There are many different kinds of hope. We can hope for an end to wars. We can hope for a strong society. We can hope for cures for many different diseases. We can hope for a strong economy. We can hope for happiness for our families. The list for hopes is endless. But whatever the hope may be, our **strongest hope must be in God**, for it is He, who guides us and upon Whom we depend with everything in our world and in our lives. Our lives are nothing without God so let us never forget the role that Our Lord Jesus plays. Let us unite in prayer and sincerely bring our heartfelt hopes, whatever they may be, to Him as a family of God.

Yes, let us raise our hearts and minds to God and humbly ask that He give us the strength to hope and to believe that He is always with us, so that we can share our hopes with Him. May we all unite **in prayer** and may we all unite **in hope**, hope which from the bottom of my heart I wish for each and every one of you. Amen.

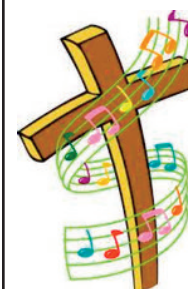
