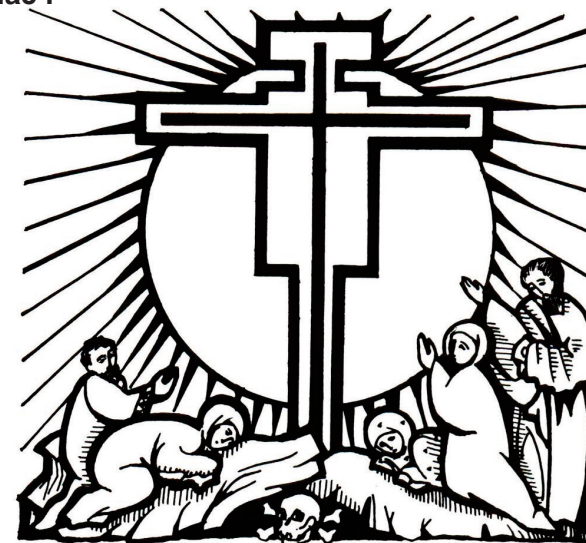

Most people procrastinate. Do you? Sooner or later we all wait for tomorrow to do something that should be done today and very often tomorrow is too late! So today I come to you with a suggestion... **don't wait!**

- Don't wait to see someone smile before you become friendly.*
- Don't wait for someone to love you – love them first.*
- Don't wait until you have tasted loneliness to understand the value of friendship.*
- Don't wait for an ideal job to start working.*
- Don't wait to have much, you can share even if you have very little.*
- Don't wait until you have a problem to appreciate advice.*
- Don't wait for pain to believe in prayer.*
- Don't wait for an ideal situation in order to offer your help to someone.*
- Don't wait to see others suffer to ask them for forgiveness.*

So many of us wait for the world to smile at us...we wait for someone to call us or to invite us... we wait for someone to come to our doorstep bearing gifts...we wait for someone to compliment us... And yet how often we forget that warmth comes **from giving, not receiving**. People are friendly to those who are friendly to them so let us not waste precious time waiting for the world to love us – **it's time to love first!**

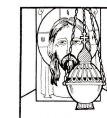
