



Dear Sisters & Brothers of Our Mother of Perpetual Help Parish,

Some years ago I was challenged to define, in a few short words, the role of the priest in the community. I responded to this challenge with the following choice words: "To comfort the disturbed and to disturb the comfortable!"



Later as I reflected upon these words, I realized how PASTOR'S DESK truly apt and appropriate were these words a reflection of the Mission of Jesus, not only during His earthly lifetime, but also very much today.

It was Jesus, the Son of God, who was born among us "to comfort the disturbed" - that is, to heal those who were hurting, to cure the broken-hearted and the crippled, to ease the pain of those struggling with the trials and tribulations of life, to provide comfort to those searching and yearning for greater life, to touch the lonely and the lost with love and kindness and caring.

Your needs and hurts should, God willing, also be mine. Your frustrations and struggles should be mine too. Your successes and joys are at the same time my successes and joys. I promise to do my best to know you and serve you and to help you on your *spiritual journey of faith*.

I will always try to *comfort* you, to provide the love and care of Jesus but also at times I may have to *disturb* you into challenging your faith and your religious commitment to Christ and to our Church. At times I will succeed and yes, sadly, at times I will fail, but still together we can and must challenge each other to respond to God's invitation to love one another.

My 'commission' as your Pastor is to strongly, but yet gently, encourage you and your family to follow the footsteps of Jesus - to comfort the disturbed and disturb the comfortable.

To challenge St. Mary's Parish Family to be more caring, more loving, more open, more welcoming, more Christ-like - to live up to its mandate to be not only a parish, but especially to be the "CHRIST-IAN" community, the Family of God. To be "a home where everyone feels at home, where sisters and brothers love one another and truly reach out to welcome the 'disturbed', the lonely, the rejected, the hurting 'Christs' who walk and struggle on this earth."

Each parish organization, be it the Parish Council, the Parish Choir, the Ladies' League, the Brotherhood, the Knights of Columbus, the Golden-Agers Club, the Cultural Centre, the Adult Lay Formation, the Children's Catechism program, in fact, all of our children and especially all of us adults, must take to heart this invitation of Jesus - to be "Christ" on earth.

I truly thank all the above and I also express my deep gratitude to all those who quietly and lovingly do respond and offer their gifts and talents and prayers for the greater glory of Christ, of our St. Mary's Church and for all our sisters and brothers.

May this **150**th Canadian Anniversary year be a banner year, a special year for all of us! Let us continue to respond to the needs of Christ and His Church, especially as we witness changes and transitions taking place all around us - here in Canada and United States and especially in Ukraine, the land of our forefathers, the land of our sisters and brothers! Let us ask the Holy Spirit to guide our Church and our Church leaders and all of us to grow in love, and faith, and hope!

May we truly be "Channels of Peace and Love", may we be faithful apostles of Christ as we "comfort the disturbed and disturb the comfortable"!

May the Good Lord and His Blessed Mother be with us always!
