## Slava Isusu Khrysu! Glory be to Jesus Christ!

Dear Beloved of St. Mary's and all visitors,

**"Pentecost Sunday"** traditionally has been regarded as the **'birthday'** of Holy Mother Church – for from this day forth, timid Apostles, having been filled and **'fired up'** by the Holy Spirit, began to happily preach the Good News that Jesus Christ, the Son of God, has granted us salvation and eternal life.

The **Holy Spirit** gifted them with much-needed courage, strong faith and intense desire to share this faith with others. They boldly began to preach and to invite every- one to believe, to be baptized and to pass on the Word of God... let us also then live our Christian faith more fully and witness more generously!

Our beautiful prayerful tradition of visiting the cemetery to commemorate our deceased **+loved ones** at Pentecost time has come. This Sunday we will happily gather together for a joint **Panakhyyda** at +Fr. Just please be patient as we make the **'rounds'**. Our grandparents and parents meaningfully kept this Ukrainian tradition and truly we, in turn, should not let this prayerful practice die with us. Next Sunday we will celebrate at Memorial cemetery and gradually at many of the country cemeteries... Do come and pray for your **+loved ones** - **"Lest we forget!"**

And now to return to the **"living"**...we are blessed that we have a number of loyal parishioners who are willing to serve our parish and our church in the capacity of the **Parish Council**. As you well know, the Council is very important and instrumental in having our parish run smoothly and to ensure the successful operation of our various activities. We wish to **officially install** these members into the Council during this Saturday Liturgy and we strongly encourage you and your families to pray for them. As your Pastor, I sincerely thank all the parishioners for volunteering their time and energy.

Now on a more mundane note – the **Eparchial Appeal** which funds numerous pastoral programs in our SK Ukrainian Eparchy is wrapping up and we are far from achieving our goal. Please pray how much you can generously contribute and do so!

The historic **Jaroslav Church bell** that was erected in 1923 (*possibly the oldest in our church*) has now been placed on a specially constructed stand by our Lady's Grotto and soon a park bench and planters will beautify our unique Marian shrine.

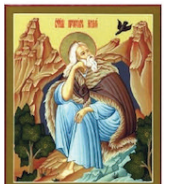
