



JAROSLAW CHURCH BELL

The oldest Ukrainian Catholic Church, the Nativity of Blessed Virgin Mary, was built in 1903 just 9 miles west of Yorkton and served our Ukrainian Catholic pioneers for generations. Sadly, it had to be demolished in 2010 because of crumbling conditions.



Through the efforts of Max Protz, Peter Protz, Carl Pacholka and Fr. Bohdan, the 1923 historic valuable bell was removed.
