DOWN and do some reflecting... This weekend we will celebrate our traditional *Forgiveness* Service... We often mistakenly think that "forgiveness" is something that we do for someone

else; yet in reality, it is a gift that we give to ourselves. Forgiving someone means being willing to overlook the wrong and pain that has been committed against you and then wisely moving on with your life. Indubitably part of you will strongly resist saying "What? Forgive them? Did you see what they did to me? I will never forgive!"

But <u>you must</u> forgive! "Not forgiving" keeps you in an eternal struggle. Whereas, the willingness to forgive can bring a sense of peace and well-being. It effectively lifts anxiety and liberates you from depression. It enhances your low self-esteem and gives you much needed hope.

Whether you committed a sin or someone else committed it against you is not so important! If you are obsessing about it, YOU are the one who must act to change things. Who cares who started it! What is more urgent is who will end it. This is not to say that there is no such thing as right and wrong. Certainly, there are such things as aggression, dishonesty, and faithlessness. But if you are not willing to move on from the wrong done to you, this could be more painful for you than the original "hurt".

Please do not foster a grudge for long periods of time. And for God's sake and yours, do not be angry for months or years. Yes, perhaps you were the "wounded innocent". The fault may be completely theirs. Yet you are the one who is a prisoner within...

We are not only called to forgive huge transgressions. There are hundreds of things in our daily lives that also need our forgiveness. Forgive those who cut you off in traffic. Forgive the person who stole your parking space. Forgive the one who took that last piece of cake that you had been waiting for. Forgive those who ignore you and forgive those who gossip about you. Forgive the person who was late and made you wait all afternoon. Forgive the person who laughed at you. And especially forgive yourself for the stupid and harmful things that you did to yourself!

Yes, forgive and forgive... and really listen to the words of your daily prayer: "Father, forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us" It is so true, it is not always easy to forgive by one's own strength but then we are not alone! We have an everloving God to Whom we can turn for help. Remember how He looked down upon His tormentors from the cross and forgave them. God does give us the grace to do the same. We must sincerely pray for this great blessing!

FASTING REGULATIONS FOR GREAT LENT

Simple Fasting requires the faithful not to consume meat, during all Fridays throughout the year, including the Holy Season of Great Lent, with certain exceptions.

Simple Fasting is recommended on Wednesdays, during the Holy Season of Great Lent for the intention of world peace, gratitude for the gift of life and for vocations to the priesthood and religious life.

Strict Fasting requires the faithful not to consume meat, eggs and dairy products. Strict Fasting occurs on the first day of Great Lent, February 12th and on Good Friday, March 30th.

The following have been given a general dispensation from fasting:

- persons who are spiritually or physically ill - sick and

- sick and convalescent

- pregnant women and nursing mothers

- those who work strenuously

- those who have reached the age of 60 years

Bishops, pastors and confessors may grant a dispensation from the fasting guidelines in case of necessity, in conformity with the spirit of our Church.

BISHOP VELYCHKOVSKY PILGRIMAGE TO UKRAINE A SPIRITUAL JOURNEY FOLLOWING A MARTYR'S LIFE JULY 8 - 29, 2018

The Bishop Velychkvosky Martyr's Shrine is conducting its 5th Velychkovsky Pilgrimage to Ukraine July 8th-29th, 2018. For 22 days we will be visiting places where Blessed Martyr Vasyl lived, worked and suffered. Some of the places will include: Lviv, Ternopil, Ivano-



Frankivsk, Kovel, Kamianetz Podilsk, Kyiv, the Carpathian Mountains, Zarvanytsia, Pochaiv, etc.

On this pilgrimage, we will have prayer services and hear stories of Blessed Vasyl's life as well as sight-seeing throughout Ukraine. Cost of the trip is \$4500 CDN which includes: flights from Winnipeg to Lviv/Kyiv to Winnipeg, travelling in air-conditioned bus throughout Ukraine, accommodations, meals and attractions.
