

Beloved Parishioners and Guests.

The sacred symbol of Christianity is a **Cross**, for it is on that instrument that our salvation was won by Jesus **Christ**. So, as we approach the halfway point of Lent, the Church presents the Cross for our edification and encouragement. If we want to know how much God values us, we turn to the Cross. With deep respect and appreciation, we honour **PASTOR'S DESK** the Cross today by singing: *"To Your Cross, O Master, we* **PASTOR'S DESK**

bow in veneration and we glorify Your Holy Resurrection". We do not have to look hard to see how prominent crosses are. They are visible on churches, in cemeteries, in homes, and are most often worn around the neck by many Christians. A cross now crowns the summit of Germany's highest mountain. It has replaced the "irminsul", the symbol of ancient German paganism. The inscription on the Cross is worth our attention: "The world may pass away, the Cross will stay."

Google the site: World's top 19 largest crosses and view these totally impressive crosses, be they on Mt Lindo, Colorado, in Spain, Philippines, Chile, Lebanon, Austria, etc... All to express gratitude and praise to Jesus who died on the cross for you and me...

The wisdom of our Church has us 'crossing ourselves' ever so frequently during our Divine Liturgies and all our church services. The Cross is a source of Hope now and hereafter, in danger and in peace. It aptly epitomizes the assurance of victory and gives us much needed courage in the most trying times of our lives.

The Holy Cross possesses power beyond measure: it protects people from violent death, as many soldiers in combat can attest. Sometimes it gives us hints on how to avoid impending danger and disaster.

A jumbo jet, coming from Japan, soared into a dense fog on its approach to San Francisco. Visibility was almost nil. The pilot circled above the clouds, awaiting a signal from the control tower. Suddenly, the flying crew caught sight of the glittering golden cross, mounted on the spire of the San Francisco cathedral. The captain guickly got his bearings and directed the jet to a safe landing, thanks to the guiding cross...


If we believe in the power of the Holy Cross and use it in our daily lives, it will give us guidance and victory also. The first Christian Emperor, Constantine the Great, achieved victory over his pagan enemies through the power of the Holy Cross, as historians have recorded.

On this Veneration of the Cross Sunday, let us renew our faith in the Holy Cross and carry our personal crosses with courage and hope. May we all do our best to extol the Holy Cross and make it the foundation of our lives....

Third in the Podcast Series on Discovering the Unity of Life and Love :

Discovering the Unity of Life and Love is a document of the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops, which in our Family and Life Office podcast will be divided up into "bite sized" chunks, narrated by our own Bishop Bryan and followed up by either some thought provoking discussions or web links to help us go deeper and explore important questions like "what it means to be human-male and female?"; "the compatibility of faith and science"; "the role of beauty in our faith"; "how do we discover the true meaning of love?"; "what is true human freedom?" and many more. This Sunday's segment read by Bishop Bryan will be reading on the topic of human freedom. Probably the most called upon concept to justify almost anything the document explores the purpose and limit of human freedom. The section on Further Reflection will provide a web link to a keynote speech delivered by Bishop Robert Barron at the 2015 World meeting of Families. 
