

Christ is Risen! Truly He is Risen!

Our world is full of doors... we have them in our houses, in our cars, trains, planes and everywhere else for that matter. We open them all the time and we don't even stop to think about the fact that for a door to be a door, it must be able to move ... otherwise it will just be a mere wall. Sometimes we do not have a key to a door but, oh how often, it is WE who are in the position to open or close doors for ourselves and for others!

But do we open them? Or do we slam them shut or bolt them **PASTOR'S DESK** through prejudice and intolerance and shut them so tightly that there is

no hope of even a crack to open. Since we hold the key, do we have dozens of reasons why the door must be kept shut, not realizing that there are those who have as much right to be on the inside as we do?

Yes, a closed door can keep people outside... but it can also lock someone inside. It can shelter and protect and insure privacy and allow one to do what one pleases. When we are out in the open, we often constrain our behaviour but closed doors from the inside sometimes give us false liberties. As soon as the door is shut you can be "yourself" and so a person who is polite. gentle, thoughtful and kind to strangers can be not so very kind to those he lives with. Yes, we must be most careful how we act behind closed doors, particularly if "being ourselves" is not very charitable!

As we live our lives, we constantly open our doors and we close them. The wisdom is to know when to open and when to close them. Perhaps it would be wise to turn to Jesus for an example... for He knows all about closed doors and what goes on behind them. He knows how it feels to be despised and rejected. He knows all about various disappointments. He can recognize hypocrisy. He has seen the abuse of political power. He Himself has experienced injustice, suffering and pain. And now, He sees the closed doors that keep us divided from each other, the closed doors that make us enemies and strangers to each other.

Perhaps that is why Jesus simply knocks on our doors. It is our choice: whether to let Him in or not. He is asking to be invited. He is not pushing the door open; He is not breaking the door down. He is not insisting that we make room for Him in our lives. He invites us... and He awaits our invitation! God wants to draw us near, so He can shower us with His love, and mercy. and compassion!

With God's help perhaps we can extend our invitations and open the doors of our hearts and minds, not only to Jesus, but also to everyone else whom He created. How often there are people begging to be allowed entrance into our lives and yet we do not unbolt our door. We are busy... or we are too comfortable... or we think that we are above a certain calibre of people. Sometimes we are so poisoned with distrust and prejudice that this paralyzes us from turning any kind of door knob!

Please...Let us open the doors of our lives, both personally and as a parish, so that everyone may feel safe in both our homes and in our church. "Be of one mind, loving toward one another, sympathetic, compassionate, humble. Do not return evil for evil, or insult for insult; but, on the contrary, be a blessing, because to this you were called, that you might inherit a blessing." (1 Peter 3:8-10)

Let us take this message to heart and make the doors to our homes and to our hearts be a true symbol of understanding, generosity and warmth...




