

Beloved Parishioners and Guests,

Fr. Frank Szadiak, who once faithfully served here in Yorkton, wrote some wonderful words about **Mothers** which I sincerely wish to quote:

"Mothers are precious and irreplaceable. Today we honour them in a special way and thank them for their heroic caring, tenderness and love. This tribute extends to our bio-



logical mothers, God-mothers, and 'mothers of the heart". These include adoptive and foster parents, teachers, nurses, religious sisters, and all others who give motherly love to countless children. We honour you today, pray for you and wish you a truly **Happy Mother's Day.**

Today and throughout the month of May, we also honour our spiritual **Mother**. God saw to it that the world was given the most beautiful ideal of motherhood in **Mary**. Mary shows us the immediate concerns of motherhood. She frets over her child Jesus. At the same time her brow radiates the holiness of beauty and the beauty of holiness. Mary has remained for us the most gentle and most blessed name in history for motherly love.

A mother's love is not only unselfish and undying, but is a constant inspiration to her children of what it means to be a <u>loving human being</u>. Being loved and expressing love are absolutely necessary for developing wholesome and successful relationships.

A mother automatically knows through her faith, intuition and love the need to forgive. And forgiveness is called upon often. From minor irritations to major offenses, children need to be forgiven. At times, a loving response includes a just punishment, but never resentment.

Together, *mom* and *dad* strive to make their house a *home* where a true Christian atmosphere prevails: love of God, respect for one another, acceptance, and hospitality. **Home** is the place where children learn responsibility, discipline and self-worth.

Most importantly, a mother teaches her children about God – that He is our Creator and Saviour, and that He is our dearest friend. As first teachers, mom and dad show their children how to pray, to live their faith and how to worship. In this way, a child can grasp the deepest meaning of life and its preciousness.

We often take our mothers for granted. **Mother's Day** reminds us to say, "Thank you! I appreciate all that do for me."

If your relationship with your mother has waned over the years, renew it now. Make it what it should be. If your mother is no longer with you, pray for her. If you are fortunate enough to have her still with you, lift her up in prayer and tell her that you love her! *Mnohaya Lita, Mom!* You are the greatest!"



Memorial Services Blessing of Graves


May 20 - Yorkton City Cemetery 1:00 pm May 27 - Memorial Gardens 1:00 pm

ARCHANGEL MICHAEL INTRODUCTION TO ICON WRITING AT ST. MICHAEL'S CAMP May 31 to June 2

This is an introduction to egg tempera iconography and the spirituality of an iconographer. Our main goal is to pray and creating an icon will be secondary. Participants will be exposed to skills and techniques required to woodwork, gesso, gold leaf and paint with egg tempera.

We will be working at the same speed. (Perfectionists will be frustrated because I will not give sufficient time to finish each step before moving on to the next step.) Each participant will go home with their own icon.



The cost for the workshop (Thursday 6:30 pm to Sat 9:00 pm) is \$300 per person. The breakdown is as follows: \$125.00 for materials. Each night you spend at camp (Thursday and Friday) will cost \$50.00 x 2 = \$100.00. Food will cost \$75.00 for groceries and we will cook for ourselves.

If you choose to participate in both the optional workshops, board making (Wednesday 6:30- 9:30pm) and gesso (Thursday 9:00am to 2:00pm) you will be charged additional fees of \$100.00. The breakdown is as follows: \$40.00 for materials and \$60.00 donation for the camp. Additional nights of accommodation will cost \$50.00 each and food costs will be negotiated at the time of registration.
