“Pentecost Sunday” traditionally has been regarded as the birthday of Holy Mother Church – for from this day forth, the Apostles, having been filled and *“fired up”* by the Holy Spirit, began to preach the **Good News** that Jesus Christ, the Son of God, has granted us salvation and eternal life!

The Holy Spirit gifted them with courage and faith and intense desire to share this faith with others. They boldly began to preach and to invite everyone to believe and be baptized and to pass on the Word of God... let us also live our faith more fully and witness more generously!

Our beautiful prayerful tradition of visiting the cemetery to commemorate our deceased **+loved ones** at Pentecost time has come. This Sunday we will happily gather together at the City cemetery for a joint Panakhyda at **+Father Delaere's cairn at 1:30 pm** to pray for all the deceased Redemptorists and for all the parish +loved ones, called to the Heavenly Kingdom. After this, everyone is encouraged to proceed to their family graveside and we Fathers will gladly come and sing a *Vichnaya Pamiat* and bless the graves. Just please be patient as we make the 'rounds'.

Our grandparents and parents meaningfully kept this Ukrainian tradition alive and truly we, in turn, should not let this prayerful practice die with us. Next Sunday we will celebrate at **Memorial Gardens** cemetery at **1:30 pm** and gradually at many of the country cemeteries... Do come and pray for your +loved ones - **“Lest we forget!”**

Now to return to the present and the future – we are always trying to stabilize the financial status of our parish and truly we do depend on your weekly church donation. Our expenses constantly are ever with us, even if you are not here with us. 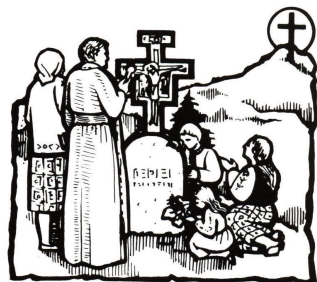

INTRODUCTION TO ICON WRITING AT ST. MICHAEL'S CAMP

MAY 31 TO JUNE 2

This is an introduction to egg tempera iconography and the spirituality of an iconographer. Our main goal is to pray and creating an icon will be secondary. Participants will be exposed to skills and techniques required to wood-work, gesso, gold leaf and paint with egg tempera.

We will be working at the same speed. (Perfectionists will be frustrated because I will not give sufficient time to finish each step before moving on to the next step.) Each participant will go home with their own icon.

The cost for the workshop (Thursday 6:30 pm to Sat 9:00 pm) is \$300 per person. The breakdown is as follows: \$125.00 for materials. Each night you spend at camp (Thursday and Friday) will cost \$50.00 x 2 = \$100.00. Food will cost \$75.00 for groceries and we will cook for ourselves.

If you choose to participate in both the optional workshops, board making (Wednesday 6:30- 9:30pm) and gesso (Thursday 9:00am to 2:00pm) you will be charged additional fees of \$100.00. The breakdown is as follows: \$40.00 for materials and \$60.00 donation for the camp. Additional nights of accommodation will cost \$50.00 each and food costs will be negotiated at the time of registration.
