

Beloved Parishioners and Guests,

Truly hope you had a wonderful summer with vacations, travel and relaxation! How quickly the summer did pass and now we soon will be back into the swing of things – like meetings, projects, parish events, school, adult and children's programs, etc. Welcome back!

FROM THE

My summer definitely was different, especially after **PASTOR'S DESK** my six by-pass surgery, which meant I was suppose to take

it easy and recover slowly. Well, I tried, but not always with success! Yes, I daily managed my 5-6 km walk and also many rest periods to recuperate between pastoral duties, like funerals, weddings, anniversaries, many Liturgies, hospital and nursing visits, etc., etc. Yes, I am still walking daily and exercising...

May I sincerely **thank you** with my whole new *"mended heart"* for your prayers, your love and your support... it is good, very good to be alive among you all!

Last Sunday I painfully shared about two tragedies in my Sunday sermon – the killing of 4 fellow Canadians in Fredericton and the great support at the Memorial service which expressed much pride and honour in our police forces... In the second tragedy I expressed much shame and sorrow and anger at the report of over 300 sick and corrupted priests who abused so many innocent children and the horrible cover-up by the bishops which caused more children to suffer great pain and loss. I could not help but deliver my thoughts with tears and pain and even personal anguish! So sad and so sinful! Truly my heart is torn apart. The institution of the church failed horribly, many times not listening to the victims, but instead protecting itself and the priest or bishop abusers, thus, increasing the anguish and pain. How very wrong!

To quote my own sermon, I tearfully shared that "I can't speak for teachers, or police, or other Christian churches who have abused children, I can only speak as a Catholic priest to apologize and to beg forgiveness for the harm, the suffering, and the injustice the Church has perpetuated upon children and to ask each of you to pray that the impurities and the sins of an imperfect church will be removed and, God forbid, that these horrific crimes never happen again." Even now I beg forgiveness of you!

Let us not lose our faith in Our Lord Jesus who founded the Catholic Church that must be so much more faithful to Him. Let us be in the forefront as we strive to lead our Catholic church out of this shameful chapter in its history. May it be purified of all this shame and sorrow!


