Please let us not take our 'blessings' for granted. Let Thanks-giving weekend be a precious time for 'giving thanks'. Let us warmly develop an "Attitude of Gratitude"! What a great difference this will make for



And speaking of Gratitude, we, as a parish, truly must express our warmest Thank You to faithful parishioners, who are called into the Heavenly Kingdom, but chose in their Last Will & Testament to appoint St. Mary's as a special beneficiary of their Estate. Three years ago I warmly recall that +Walter Lukey was most grateful for his active participation in this worshipping community and therefore, gifted the parish with a generous donation, knowing that we, in turn, will use these funds to help others and that we will pray daily for him – as we pray for all our benefactors and parishioners. How good this would be if more parishioners followed his example...

It has always deeply disturbed me, wherever I have served as Pastor, to discover that so many of our Ukrainian citizens do not have a Last Will and Testament. Apparently in Canada this figure is frighteningly near 50%. It's almost as if we have inadvertently convinced ourselves that if we do not make a Will, then we will not die! The reality is, I, as your Pastor am preparing for this final day on earth and so must YOU!

You have worked so very hard to provide for yourself and your family and it only makes good sense that YOU choose what happens to your inheritance. Without a Will and Last Testament, our government will gladly dispose of your hard-earned savings (or lawyers will choose for you!)

One of the great joys of writing a Last Will is that YOU personally choose to whom you offer your riches and your possessions (no matter how large or small!). We all have heard horror stories of families destroying themselves by actually fighting over the deceased "possessions" after a funeral. What a sad and pitiful sight – and this is the result of people not taking time to make these important decisions during their life time.

Following +Walter Lukey's and other good examples, we strongly encourage all Catholics, all parishioners, to also consider making provision in your Will for the continuing financial support of St. Mary's Parish. This is a wonderful way to, not only thank God for the blessings that we have received, but also to ensure our church is able to meet the needs of future generations. A Gift that "Keeps on Giving..." is a living testimony of your generosity!

Whoops! Was this too heavy? I realize it is – but my job as your pastor is to challenge you in all aspects of life - spiritually, emotionally, mentally and even financially! I hope you don't mind too much! In the meantime, I wish you a beautiful, peaceful, joyful, loveful and even a little 'lukieful' week...
