Dear Beloved Parishioners and Guests.

A few weeks ago I had a conversation with a young man and found that I strongly disagreed with his point of view. And I will admit that I was ready to be angry with him but then I remembered something that someone once suggested that I do in a such a situation like this and, instead of getting angry, I imagined that I was him!



I pretended that I came from his background, his family and his job. I truly tried to imagine his emotional state – I tried to

imagine who influences his way of thinking, what pleases him, what disappoints him and what this person takes so very much for granted. And, all of a sudden, some of the anger that I was tempted to feel died down.

We, all of us, tend to see life through a prism of our own experience. We tend to forget that every person has a different viewpoint and that they might have a reason to think differently from you or me and most of all we forget that very often we don't know the reason why they think the way they do. We should always remember that we don't have to agree with others but we must at least try to be sympathetic and considerate toward others even if we think them to be "wrong", 'foolish" or ridiculous"!

I know that each and every one of us has been in a situation where we did not understand someone or did not agree with them and so I went looking for a prayer that would show us how to pray for the understanding and the patience that we often so very much lack.

Lord, grant me the gift of understanding! Help me to understand the feelings of others, their desires and their goals in life. At the same time, help me to understand myself, in my actions and reactions. Widen my vision beyond my own small world and help me to embrace the worlds of others with love and understanding. Bless me with insight, acceptance and love. I do not understand why others suffer and do not understand why they act the way that they do, but I do know that You love others as much as You love me and that I should not be judging them.

Help me to take an interest in others and to develop an understanding toward those who need it. Help me to see what they feel they must hide and to hear what they cannot say so that I may speak with compassion. Help me to understand the power of my words and actions, so that I may touch others' lives in a positive manner. Finally, help me to occasionally step aside and see that MY view is not always the ONLY point of view. Amen

We should always work at bettering ourselves. Sometimes we should ask ourselves: "Is this really my opinion or am I just an echo of my environment and don't even stop to think about what I am saying." Some viewpoints are so deeply imbedded in us that it doesn't even occur to us that they can be changed... and that some of them SHOULD be changed. Let us be honest toward ourselves and toward others so that we can create a better world, a more

peaceful and loveful world... God bless you all!


