#### **Dear Beloved Parishioners and Guests,**

As you well know, I often write a spiritual and/or an anecdotal message in the Pastor's page. May I do something different? This week there is much interesting news about Ukraine and about Constantinople that I have been methodically reading and reviewing – so this may be a brief church history lesson about Ukraine. Please bear with me...



As Ukrainians we all know that **St. Volodymyr** of Kyiv-Rus accepted the Christian faith from Byzantium/Constantino-

ple and had all his Ukrainian subjects baptized in the Dnipro river in **988**. Our fellow Ukrainians very quickly strove to actively live this faith; in fact, within 40 years, there were over 40 majestic churches in Kyiv. the most beautiful of all **St. Sofia Cathedral** erected in **1037** and it still proudly exists, but now as a museum.

Rome was the centre of all Christianity before the **Great Schism** unfortunately took place in **1054**, thus creating the Catholic and Orthodox churches. Ukraine became predominantly Orthodox under the mantle of the Patriarch of Constantinople until **1596** when much of western Ukraine returned to the Catholic faith at the Union of Brest.

Kyiv was a strong Metropolitan Ukrainian Church until the hierarchy moved to Vilnius in the 15<sup>th</sup> c. and then, under great pressure, in **1686** the Ecumenical Patriarch transferred this Church to the Moscow Patriarch and thus for centuries Ukraine has been subjected to the Russian Church, now strongly controlled by atheistic Communists.

There are presently <u>three</u> Orthodox Churches in Ukraine, the largest sadly under the control of Moscow. Ukraine has constantly asked the Ecumenical Patriarch of Constantinople to recognize the Ukrainian Orthodox Church as canonical, independent and autocephalous, much to the displeasure of the Moscow Patriarch and President Putin.

Happily after almost 4 centuries, on **October 11**<sup>th</sup>, Patriarch Bartholomew has recognized the Patriarchate of Kyiv as a Canonical Church, totally independent of Moscow and the Russian church. Now the Ukrainian Orthodox churches can unite into one and be recognized by all Orthodox churches in the world, except the Russian church. As of **October 15**<sup>th</sup>, a great schism is now taking place because the Moscow Patriarch and President Putin have condemned this decision and have threatened repercussions.

Let us pray that the transfer of churches to the canonical Ukrainian church may not evoke bitterness, anger and violence. May we, as Catholics, support our Orthodox sisters and brothers as they and we experience this positive and timely Patriarchal decision.

On a more local scale, we are most pleased that the weather has improved and the harvest may finally take place. Therefore, all of us must be most grateful for all of our personal blessings and for God's special graces....
