### **Dear Beloved Parishioners and Guests,**

Next Sunday, **November 11<sup>th</sup>**, **100** years will have passed since the signing of the Armistice that finally officially ended the horrific WWI. We, as a parish, wish to honour all those who sacrificed their lives in defense of freedom. We therefore will participate in **Bells of Peace** as we loudly ring the bells of St. Mary's **100** times at sunset....

Just some information about our young country of Canada during the WWI: Even though just under 8 million in 1914, some 619,636 Canadians enlisted and approximately 424,000 served overseas. Almost 61,000 of our soldiers were killed and another 172,000 were wounded. Many more returned broken in mind and body, over 9000 suffered, visibly and invisibly, from "shell shock" for the rest of their troubled lives. If we are to remember those who fought, we need to drive home the message of the horror of war and its effect on the society that wages it.

Please I beg you to take time out to pray for them, to thank God for their great sacrifices and to honour them. Yes, we will have our regular Sunday Liturgies to pray on this **Remembrance Day**, but we strongly encourage all our parishioners to actively participate in the Memorial Service at the Gallagher Centre, hosted by the **Royal Canadian Legion** which takes place traditionally at **11:00 am...** 

Also it has been a custom for our **Knights of Columbus** to commemorate their Bro. Knights who have been called into the Heavenly Kingdom. A special memorial service will be celebrated here in St. Mary's at **5:00 pm**. *All are welcomed* to attend and join in the prayer. During this service our church bell will be rung **100** times just as the ringing of church bells erupted spontaneously across the country on **November 11**<sup>th</sup>, **1918**.

And speaking of dates: **November 9**th, **1749** is the <u>Foundation Day</u> of the Redemptorist Congregation, established by St. Alphonsus Liguori in Naples to care for the most abandoned Christians. Presently there is approximately **5500** Redemptorists faithfully serving in **82** countries. Our **+Fr. Achilles Delaere CSsR**, a Belgium priest, came to Yorkton in 1903 to care for the most abandoned, i.e., our Ukrainian ancestors because there were no Ukrainian priests in this area. We as a parish exist because of this holy man!

All CSsR parishes world-wise have a <u>special church collection</u> as a **Solidarity Fund** to assist in the formation of future Redemptorists in poorer countries. Please give generously to this **second** collection on **November 11**<sup>th</sup>. We will have unique envelopes available in the pews. Please list your envelope no. I warmly thank you in advance.

May the good Lord bless all of you abundantly and do know that you are very much loved....
