### **Dear Beloved Parishioners and Guests,**

In South Africa, people used to light candles and place them in their windows. **They were a sign of Hope**, a sign that one day racial discrimination would be overcome. Afraid that this practice might incite rebellion, the authorities made it illegal to have lit candles in the windows.



Eventually, apartheid was overcome. Reflecting on what contributed to its downfall, it is apparent that **lit reli-**

gious candles were more powerful than firearms or any army. We cannot underestimate the **power of Hope**.

**Hope** is powerful because it is based upon a promise of God that justice, peace, love and graciousness will eventually prevail. <u>To light a candle</u>, then, is to say that these ideals are more powerful than threats, torture, guns and a secular society. <u>To</u> light a <u>candle</u> is to proclaim to everyone that our real allegiance, trust and hope are given to Someone beyond them.

Lit candles are an integral part of our Byzantine Ukrainian religious tradition. Many of us go to the votive stand when we come to church and light a candle. We usually light it for someone who needs our prayers, if not ourselves, or just plainly to acknowledge and honour our Lord. The candle burns for a period of time and is really an extension of our personal prayers.

We need not look far for lit candles. They light up the main altar, the tetrapod, and our homes in times of storms, our tables at times of celebration, and our religious icons.

The lit candles have a deep significance. They symbolize our great Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ, who is the Light of the world.

As we prayerfully prepare for Christmas and the welcoming of Jesus, the Sun of Righteousness, our world is made brighter and more hopeful. A lit candle or Advent wreath in our window or a special decorative light can elegantly portray our expectancy and embrace of the **Prince of Peace** who will be born for us. Moreover, this is a personal sign inviting the spirit of Christ-mas to grace our home - "Come, Lord Jesus!"

Now as we count down the days before the wonderful celebration of the Jesus's Birth, let us all give thanks for the bountiful blessings we have all received and let us happily praise our God and Saviour!



### Immaculate Conception of the Mother of God



The doctrine of the immaculate Conception of the Mother of God reached its peak and triumph during the reign of Pope Pius IX (1846-1878), who by his Bull of the 8th of December, 1854, proclaimed the Immaculate Conception a dogma of faith. In this Bull it was declared "that the Most Blessed Virgin Mary in the first instant of her conception, by a singular grace and privilege granted to her by almighty God through the merits of Christ Jesus, Saviour of mankind, was preserved from

all stain of original sin - this is a doctrine revealed by God and, therefore, must be held firmly and constantly by all faithful Christians." Four years later on the 25<sup>th</sup> of March, 1858, the Most Pure Virgin Mary, in her apparition to St. Bernadette Soubirou, when asked what her name was, declared to the whole world: "I am the Immaculate Conception." The Latin Church celebrates this feast on the 8th of December. (In the Eastern Rite, we celebrate on December 9<sup>th</sup>)

3. Better Together: We as parents are the models our children follow but we can learn to pray together. On the flip side of this page is a simple method of prayer popularized by Pope Francis. I would be happy to speak with you individually about other types of prayer if you need more ideas on how to grow prayer in your personal and family life.



As a family you might try having certain prayers that you pray together such as the Our Father, Hail Mary, Guardian Angel Prayer or the prayer to St. Michael followed by giving each member of the family an opportunity to give voice to one intention in each (or even one or two) of the 5 categories, if they can think of one. Very young children may initially need help but they learn very quickly especially when we remind them about how much Jesus loves to hear their prayers. The prayers of children are very close to His heart and therefor they are very powerful!

May God bless you and your family. I pray that we all grow closer to Jesus as we prepare for the great celebration of His birth, so we might truly experience that God is With Us!

We struggle with this when it comes to passing on our faith as we may feel that we need a super-hero sort of faith to pass it on to our kids—especially in the world today where we feel very little support in this endeavor. However, there are some practical things we can do to make a difference in our spiritual lives and those of our children.

### Giving the gift of prayer this Christmas:

One of the most significant things about passing on the faith to our children, is passing on the ability to pray. Some of us have negative experiences of being forced to pray and there are others for whom prayer was not a part of family life at all. For both those groups the question remains is how do I develop a real relationship with God in prayer and pass that on to my kids. I may want my children to know God's love and presence in their lives--but I may not have a clue of how to do this.

My own experience has taught me a few things about this struggle and how to overcome the obstacles in the way of personal and family prayer. These are a few of my thoughts:

- 1. Just Do It! Prayer, like good communication, does not necessarily come naturally and requires work. This does not mean it needs to be unbearable or painful but it does require a dedicated time and discipline, especially to get started. So, the Church Fathers have told us to have 'rule of prayer'. What that is for you and your family is something you must decide, but without some kind of commitment, and desire to overcome inertia and distraction we will not make progress. Small achievable goals are usually best, growth is always possible.
- 2. HELP! In order to be meaningful, we need to be completely honest with God and not overly complicate the process of developing a relationship with Him. That is not to say that we might not use formulas such as the Rosary or the Jesus Prayer but is to affirm the need to pray from our heart with complete honesty. If I am worried about something but fail to mention it to God I may find my experience hollow and just one of going through the motions. It is only through faith that we can come to a place where we believe God cares. But, actually bringing our needs to Christ can build our faith as well. No, God may not always answer our prayers the way we want but He will always answer us and bring good from every situation if we let Him. (Rom. 8:28) As we experience these answers it builds our faith. It affirms our faith in who God is—the almighty and all powerful who loves me and you. Personal understanding of this is what leads to worship and thanksgiving as well as the desire to love and follow Christ and the teachings of His Church.

This is power of God, working in our lives, that can transform us.
