

Cyber Safety: Tips for Parents

As Christmas approaches electronics are often high on the wish lists for many of our young people. Although most of us have some vague notions about the need for cyber-safety, many of us a blithely unaware of what we can do to make the internet a safer place for our children. So here are some tips:

- 1. Talk to your kids about where they go and what they do online. Open communication is a must!
- 2. Discuss how to be a good 'online citizen' and what your family's values are regarding what is acceptable and what is not. In that regard consider getting family accountability software such as 'Covenant Eyes'. This really is an absolute must regardless of what kind of screening software you might use. If you don't know what accountability software is 'google' Covenant Eyes. Porn sites know how to find and hook kids on their wares...good Catholic boys and girls...even young kids...please do not disregard this caution!
- 3. Insist on passwords & ask that kids not share these with even their closest friends. Parents always have a right to know where their kids are going and that includes where they go online. Parents always have the right to know what their minor children's pass words are!
- 4. Share with Care: Younger children should not be allowed to post any personal information or pictures online. That goes doubly for online chat rooms. (Parents should consider whether they would want an online predator looking at pics of their kids before posting them online as well.) For older kids remind them that what they post can be ammunition for cyber bullies or people who may want to take advantage of them. Reinforce that once something is in cyberspace—including even that which is sent privately via text or email—is potentially there forever and could be shared with anyone.
- 5. Don't respond to a bully or try to defend yourself—the rule of thumb is STOP; BLOCK and TELL.
- **6.** Think before you click—never click on email/text links unless you are 100% certain they are safe, even when they are from people you know.

Report on the Special General Meeting of the Bishop Budka Eparchial Stewardship Society Inc

At the Special General Meeting of the Bishop Budka Eparchial Stewardship Society Inc (BBESSI) held on December 9, 2018 the membership voted to approve the amended Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws that transitioned BBESSI to a Foundation. There were two important changes that occurred at this meeting.

- 1) Name Change: The name of Bishop Budka Eparchial Stewardship Society Inc was changed to the Ukrainian Catholic Foundation of Saskatchewan Corporation.
- 2) A new Board of Directors was established in accordance with the amended and approved bylaws. The new Board consists of the Eparch, four appointed Directors by the Eparch, and four Directors elected by the membership, representing each Deanery in the Eparchy. - Appointed by the Eparch and representing the Finance Council: Glen Lekach (Regina)
- Appointed by the Eparch and representing the Eparchial Pastoral Council: Geraldine Koban (Yorkton)
- Appointed by the Eparch and the member-at- large: Ernest Boyko (Saskatoon)
- Elected and representing the Prince Albert Deanery: Larry Danylyshen (Prince Albert)
- Elected and representing the Regina Deanery: Terry Shalley (Regina)
- Elected and representing the Saskatoon Deanery: Bob Friesen (Saskatoon)
- Elected and representing the Yorkton Deanery: Doreen Rathgeber (Yorkton)
- 3) Subsequently, the Board elected a new Executive as follows: Chair Bob Friesen; Vice-Chair Ernest Boyko; Treasurer Terry Shalley; Secretary Doreen Rathgeber
