We all experience life-changing moments, as did I on June 8th – to discover 7 major blockages to my heart and the immediate need for a 6 by-pass surgery, which could mean "life or death". How blessed I was - to have precious time to prepare! Yes, I celebrated the Sacraments of Reconciliation, Holy Eucharist and Holy Anointing and to sincerely say, "Lord Jesus, Thy will be done!" 100's of people faithfully prayed for a success- **PASTOR'S DESK**

Time in a hospital gives us a painful opportunity to reflect and pray and I penned these personal thoughts on the 5th day from my bed:

"Now I better understand how people feel when they are confined by an illness in a hospital for a longer time... I now promise to be much more compassionate and caring...

"Now I know we don't really call all the "shots in life"- definitely up to the good Lord to give us wisdom enough to check out if something is "not normal" with our bodies (well, and our souls too!)...

"This spring I could not walk two blocks without chest and arm pains... Yes, this was 'abnormal' for me and so wisely(!) I acquiesced and willingly reached out for medical advice...

"The good Lord Jesus blesses us with excellent doctors to check out our bodies and sometimes good priests also to check out our souls... may I say I personally try to be the such a priest!

"Now I know that we often ignore signs for weeks and maybe months, before we humbly acknowledge we need help... how wise is that?

"Now I admit that hospitals are not the greatest places, but thank God, for our Health system, for our hospitals and all the healing staff who patiently use their skills and learning to make us better.. often in spite of ourselves

"Now I willingly acknowledge I was a 'sick puppy', waiting for a massive heart attack if I had not taken this medical route - apparently 6 by- passes is a rare thing, but then I've always been unique and strange and different - you may disagree!!!

"I will honestly admit it has been a painful journey... 3 days in ICU because of some complications and then transferred to the Step Down Observation Unit for more expert care and 3 more days of care....

"All the patients here at the Royal University Hospital (and other hospitals too!) receive excellent care from a wonderful professional medical staff - doctors, residents, nurses, therapists, etc... all who work with diligent devotion and dedication ... and how very grateful I am!"

Now may I humbly, as your Pastor and friend, sincerely and heart-fully thank all of you for your goodness to me - for your many Divine Liturgies, your prayers and sacrifices, for the get-well cards and sentiments, the fruit baskets and yes, the flowers, and your generous love and constant support...

I also express appreciation especially to Frs. Ray and Methodius who have graciously taken on my pastoral responsibilities, and to our loyal office staff...

May the good Lord Jesus, the great Healer and His Blessed Mother reward you with many joyful and abundant blessings....



Welcome Вітаємо

Слава Ісусу Христу !

Glory be to Jesus Christ !

Thank you for praying and visiting with us at St. Mary's. Before you leave please take some time to admire some of our treasures.

Our Dome depicts a beautiful original artwork of the Coronation of Mary, the Mother of God, in heaven. It is the work of the late Stephen Meush, who undertook this work at the age of 36. It took years to complete (1939-1941).

The Icon of Our Mother of Perpetual Help behind the altar was written by Igor Sulhacev of Toronto and was installed in 1964. It is a representation of the original Miraculous Icon which is venerated today in the church of St. Alphonsus in Rome. Pope Pius X entrusted this Miraculous Icon to the Redemptorists with the instruction: "See to it that Our Mother of Perpetual Help is made known throughout the world." It is most fitting that the Icon of Our Mother of Perpetual Help holds the place of honour in our church, the Motherhouse of the Ukrainian Catholic Redemptorists.

The Bust of Fr. Achilles Delaere, CSsR, located in the south entrance of the church, is a creation of the famous Ukrainian Canadian artist Leo Mol of Winnipeg. Fr. Delaere, a Belgian Roman Catholic priest of the Redemptorist Congregation, saw the great spiritual needs of the early Ukrainian immigrants. Knowing that these people did not have their own priest, Fr. Delaere, along with other Redemptorists "became" Ukrainian Catholic in order to serve the early immigrants. This year marks the 150th anniversary of his birth. *The Altar* was installed in 1965. It is also the creation of Igor Sulhacev. At the base of the altar are 28 figurines, representing saints of the Eastern Church.

The Icon of the First Ukrainian Catholic Redemptorist Martyrs. On June 27, 2001, Pope John Paul II beatified 27 martyrs for the Ukrainian Catholic Church. Among these heroes of faith are four Redemptorists:

Bishop Nicholas Charnetsky, CSsR, Bishop Vasyl Velychkovsky, CSsR, Fr. Zenon Kovalyk, CSsR & Fr. Ivan Ziatyk, CSsR

This icon depicting these holy ones was written by Fr. Thomas Loya of Chicago. It was installed and blessed during St. Mary's Annual "Vidpust" Pilgrimage in June 2002.
