




#### **Beloved Parishioners and Guests,**

Many years ago, professor Stuart Black of the University of Edinburgh was listening to his students as they presented oral readings. When one young man rose to begin his recitation, he held his book in the wrong hand. The professor thundered, "Take your book in your right hand and be seated!"

At this harsh rebuke, the student held up his right arm. He didn't have a right hand! The other students shifted uneasily in their chairs. For a moment the professor hesitated. Then he made his way to the student, put his arm around him, and with tears streaming from his eyes, said, "I never knew about it. Please, will you forgive me?"

Sooner or later we are all Professor Stuart Blacks. We might not always be as harsh in our criticism, but we still do criticize. We criticize with words loudly; we criticize even secretly. We forget that our criticism

Even though criticism may sometimes come with good intentions, it can still often have **negative effects** on others. "We were just trying to be helpful; we were just trying to share our personal experience..." However, more often than not, the only thing that these "good intentions" produce is anger or resentment. Our good intentions defeat the purpose entirely! Our "innocent" criticism can be destructive and can have negative effects on performance, on self esteem... and often makes matters worse rather than better...

We should always remember that when we voice our criticism, we are voicing our personal opinion. Even if it is based on fact, it is still just a <u>subjective evaluation</u>. And whether we intend it this way or not... the fact is that <u>often</u> we are "in the wrong".

As difficult as it may seem to do, let us try to be understanding. Let us generously build up, rather than tear down. Let us focus on the **positive** and not on the negative. Instead of criticizing, let us try to be more encouraging. **Love and encouragement** will produce much more positive results than spoken criticism! And let us try to remember that for as much power as words have to destroy, they have even more power to build wonderful worlds and new dreams!

How very much we imitate our **Saviour Jesus** with our kind words and generous actions! During this pre-Lenten season, we can graciously bring the presence of God into someone's life with a warm word: "I have been thinking of you!" "You know, I believe in you!" Good words, simple words, positive words spoken at the right time and the right place can make all the difference in the world in the lives of all you meet!

"Stop judging, that you may not be judged. "For as you judge, so will you be judged and the measure with which you measure will be measured out to you. Why do you notice the splinter in your brother's eye, but do not perceive the wooden beam in your own eye?... You hypocrite, remove the wooden beam from your eye first, then you will see clearly to remove the splinter from your brother's eye." (Matthew 7:1-5)

Jesus is speaking these challenging words to **you and me!** Let us be attentive and take them to heart! Let us try always to be positive and life-giving in our words and actions.... God bless you!



## Feast of the (Encounter) Presentation of Our Lord Into the Temple - February $2^{\mbox{\tiny ND}}$

On this Feast day, we see Jesus forty days old, carried into the temple in Jerusalem by Mary and Joseph, to be recognized as God's Messiah by the aged Simeon and Anna.

In obedience to the Law of Moses, the Lord Jesus, the first-born, was presented in the Temple by his Blessed Mother and his foster father. Joseph and Mary brought the Child Jesus into the temple along with a humble sacrifice of young pigeons as a sign of thanksgiving.



In Jerusalem at that time there lived a man, Simeon, who was just and devout. According to tradition, Simeon had been visited by an angel of the Lord who foretold him that he would not see death before seeing the Messiah born of the Virgin. Led by the Holy Spirit into the temple on the day that the holy family brought the Child Jesus to fulfill the law, Simeon took the Child into his arms and blessed God by saying: "Lord, now let Your servant depart in peace, according to Your word; for my eyes have seen Your salvation, which You have prepared before the face of all people, a light to lighten the gentiles, and the glory of Thy people Israel" (Luke 2:29-32). This is another 'epiphany' celebration insofar as the Christ Child is revealed as the Messiah through the canticle and words of Simeon and the testimony of Anna the prophetess who was also in the temple that day. Christ is the light of the nations, hence the blessing of candles on this day.

Simeon and Anna represent the true Israel of God. They have kept the law given through Moses. They have worshiped in the holy place, the Temple, and they are alive to the unexpectedness of God's providence.

Simeon and Anna are inspired by the Holy Spirit to see in this child the Holy One of Israel, long awaited. They themselves are old and have grown old in the service of God. They have that widened perception which comes with continual praying.
