Beloved Parishioners and Guests,

One of the most descriptive images of a "*parish*" is the "family unit" - its beginnings, its growth and its continuity. For a few moments let us reflect upon this and, God willing, come to appreciate the specialness and preciousness of a living and loving Community of Worship.



The "family" begins as a very small loving unit with dreams and visions of the future. It struggles to establish deep roots and strengthen itself. It rejoices with its successes and even grows with its setbacks and failures. It continues with a strong belief that God will always be with it.

The "parish family" also has a small beginning. Two or three and often more families group together to support each other, to enjoy one another, to pray with each other and to establish a 'worshipping centre' where they will ensure a future for themselves and their children.

And just as a healthy family experiences many stages of growth under the loving guidance of caring and loving parents, so must any parish experience varying and challenging stages of growth and change.

Back in **1910**, a young vibrant Belgian Redemptorist – Fr. **Achilles Delaere** CSsR – who devoted his whole life to serve the Ukrainian immigrants in the Yorkton/Ituna districts, established our parish church – **Our Mother of Perpetual Help** – and numerous country parishes in the surrounding area.

This Yorkton parish truly was the guiding light and beacon for the thousands of Ukrainian immigrants as they gathered to worship and pray in their Byzantine Ukrainian Rite. The first convent and Catholic school in Sask., conducted by the Sister Servants, and the first boarding school for young teenagers, organized by the Christian Brothers, were established here in Yorkton to educate 1000's of our Ukrainians. Many of the church organizations and conventions were celebrated here in the presence of Metropolitan Sheptytsky and our first Ukrainian Bishop Budka. So many more historic highlights centered around this parish and community.

As a family grows and expands, so had our St. Mary's parish. Thousands of Ukrainian families over the years were spiritually nourished here. However, just as young people leave home and establish new roots elsewhere, so have many of our parishioners. The family home, at times, expands and diminishes as members come and go. Our parish has likewise undergone this natural growing pattern.

This parish has witnessed, not only many happy celebrations of baptisms and marriages, but also many sad farewells of parishioners who have moved or been called into the Heavenly Kingdom. May God generously bless them all!

Nevertheless, with God's blessings and the continual commitment of many parishioners – new and old- St. Mary's has over the years been a good and faithful family. It has cared for the young and the elderly; it has been a "welcome haven" for all and a spiritual "worshipping home" that has brought so very many closer to the Lord Jesus and *t*o their personal salvation.

At this time may we heart-fully thank all the parishioners who have contributed to creating and re-creating St. Mary's. May we especially express our sincere appreciation and our gratitude to all who have so devotedly served on Parish Council and all the organizations – be it, the UCWL, the Brotherhood, the Knights of Columbus, the Golden-Agers Club, the Adult Lay Formation, the Adult and Children's religious programs, the Cultural Centre, and the Parish Choirs and Cantors. All of you, as a group or as individ-

uals, have striven to make our church into a "Vibrant Parish."

May the good Lord Jesus and His Blessed Mother truly watch over us all as we offer our prayers and lives to God Our Father!





FASTING REGULATIONS FOR GREAT LENT

Simple Fasting requires the faithful not to consume meat, during all Fridays throughout the year, including the Holy Season of Great Lent, with certain exceptions.

Simple Fasting is recommended on Wednesdays, during the Holy Season of Great Lent for the intention of world peace, gratitude for the gift of life and for vocations to the priesthood and religious life. Strict Fasting requires the faithful not to consume meat, eggs and dairy products. Strict Fasting occurs on the first day of Great Lent, March 4th and on Good Friday, April 19th.

> The following have been given a general dispensation from fasting: - sick and convalescent

- persons who are spiritually or physically ill - pregnant women and nursing mothers
- those who work strenuously
- those who have reached the age of 60 years

Bishops, pastors and confessors may grant a dispensation from the fasting guidelines in case of necessity, in conformity with the spirit of our Church.


Living with Loss -Bailey's Grief Group Spring 2019





Forgiveness is choosing to love.



James G.T. Fairfield, author of <u>When You Don't Agree</u>, sees forgiveness as the first skill of self-giving love.
