I do thank you for forgiving me for the times I have failed you as your priest.

And now we are in the midst of Lent –this holy period **PASTOR'S DESK** of 40 days of preparation for the wonderful celebration of Easter. In this bulletin we have a schedule of the many various prayer times in which we can participate; we truly encourage you to do so - as an individual and as a family! I promise you will wonderfully grow in faith and in love.

Last Sunday we also conducted a very successful Parish Annual meeting (after a delicious brunch prepared by our Knights!) As pastor of the whole Yorkton district, I truly must address this issue by discussing with the various church members how best to deal with the church buildings and the property that can no longer be sustained. Even now, I encourage the former members and the few remaining, to begin the "grieving" process of saying "farewell" to a church that played a major role in their lives. This is not an easy or pleasant task!

On Saturday., March 9th, we hosted the first **Stewardship Forum** for the Eparchy as we gathered representatives from the whole Deanery to discuss these important topics with Bishop Bryan and Fr. Ivan Nahachewsky who heads the challenging **De-Commissioning** Committee . What is the least painful procedure and most Christian format for removing crumbling abandoned churches, community halls, etc.? Pray for us!

We are most pleased that Fr. John Sianchuk CSsR will conduct a 4 evening Mission for St. Mary's and the District parishes on March 24-27th. Truly a wonderful time of prayer, reflection and renewal. Please pray for our Mission and do attend... Ah! Finally the weather in the West is warming up – there may

be spring after all on the horizon... Wishing you all a peaceful, joyful, loveful and even a little "lukieful" week... See you at the Lenten services.


