Today, i.e., Sunday at the 11:00 am Divine Liturgy we happily celebrate our parish's **First Solemn Holy Communion**. Nine (9) of our precious little children have been delightfully preparing for this special day under the prayerful guidance of their parents and our committed **Diane Stadnyk**. We realize this is also OUR First Holy Communion with these children and we pray we may have this holy pleasure often!

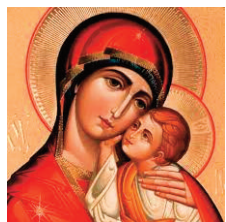
