We, as Ukrainian Redemptorists, have had the pleasure of creating and serving Our Mother of Perpetual Help parish and all the country parishes in this District for over 100 years, commencing with our saintly and visionary Father Delaere and his Belgian confreres who dedicated their lives for our early Ukrainian pioneers. Since its founding, dozens of different Pastors and many more Associate Pastors, have each generously offered their own special charisms and gifts to preach the Good News and **PASTOR'S DESK** pastorally care for all the parishioners in this area.

With our limited numbers, we are truly blessed that our Lviv Redemptorists wish to form a special community in Yorkton, just as did the Belgian Redemptorists over a 100 years ago. We truly believe that St. Mary's will welcome Fr. Leonid Malkov CSsR as Pastor of St. Mary's and Fr. Yevhen Zadorozhniy CSsR as his Assistant. Bishop Peter Stasiuk CSsR of Australia wishes to retire in Yorkton and to assist in serving all our parishes. We know you will welcome the new pastoral team with open arms and work diligently with them! And we warmly and sincerely thank each of you...

And now we gather together to wish us "fare ye well" as we, priests, continue our spiritual journey in other vineyards, knowing and believing you will care for this precious vineyard that we have cherished for so many years!

Ah! but we do have the joy of more time with our beloved St. Mary's!

When families struggle: Psychologist Phillip Sutton offers the following advice when those we love are facing struggles or engaging in behaviours we believe to be physically, emotionally or spiritually harmful. Following this advice can help us manage our response, maintain our own physical emotional and spiritual health to maximize our ability to help.

Things to remember about another's worrisome behavior: I didn't' CAUSE it. I can't CURE it. I can't CONTROL it. But I can take CARE of myself, by COMMUNICATING my feelings, needs and limits, by making healthy CHOICES, following CHRIST and believing He can bring good from EVERY situation.

'Blame' and anger are not helpful. Yes, we should take responsibility and seek forgiveness for our actions which may have in any way contributed to problems in our family but we must remember that all persons are free and responsible for their own choices. However, we need God's help in situations where we see those we love making negative choices here is where we can move from Pain to Peace:

- 1. Pray: Deepen your relationship with Jesus, seek the intercession of His Mother; ask others to pray for you and your loved one. Be open to the conversion and transformation of you own heart and ask with gratitude, for love, surrender and humility.
- 2. Personalize: Pope Benedict XVI reminded us "Look into the face of the other and see that he (or she) has a soul, a story and a life: He (or she) is a person and God loves him (or her) as he loves me."
- 3. Prepare: Seek education and truth about the prevention, causes, consequences and treatment for our loved one's desire for and habit of worrisome behavior.
- 4. **Partner:** Seek support from your family, friends, parish and support groups.
- 5. Petition: for the needs of those we love, that they may encounter the truth in love that will genuinely set them on the right path.
- 6. Participate: Get or continue to be involved in the lives of those we love—his or her interests, concerns and relationships.
- 7. Principled Prohibitions: Insist that behavior in our homes comply with our standards.
- 8. Patience and Perseverance: Christ endured the cross out of love for us; love always leads to suffering, don't give up! He loves us, even in our sinfulness and He calls us all through repentance and transformation to live in holiness.
- 9. Proclaim: Share the great things Christ has done for you, and your faith in his desire to do the same for others. Ask for the Holy Spirit to show you when to speak, and how to share your faith with love.
- 10. Have "Fun"! Scripture tells us to "Rejoice in the Lord!" and so we need to remember to have a sense of humor--focus on the things that are true, honorable, just, pure, lovely, gracious, excellent, praiseworthy," and to that list add "funny!"
