





**Prokimen**, tone 5: You, O Lord, will guard us and will keep us from this generation, and for ever. *Verse:* Save us, Lord, there are no devout men left.

**Epistle:** A reading from the Letter of the Holy Apostle Paul to the Hebrews. (1: 10 - 2: 3)

Lord of old you established the earth, and the heavens are the work of your hands. They will perish, but you remain; all of them will grow old like a garment. You will roll them up like a cloak, like a garment they will be changed. But you are the same, and your years will have no end. To which of the angels has God even said, "Sit at my right hand till I make your enemies your footstool?" Are they not all ministering spirits, sent to serve those who are to inherit salvation? In view of this, we must attend all the more to what we have heard, lest we drift away. 

For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weakness, but one who was tempted in every way that we are, yet never sinned.
