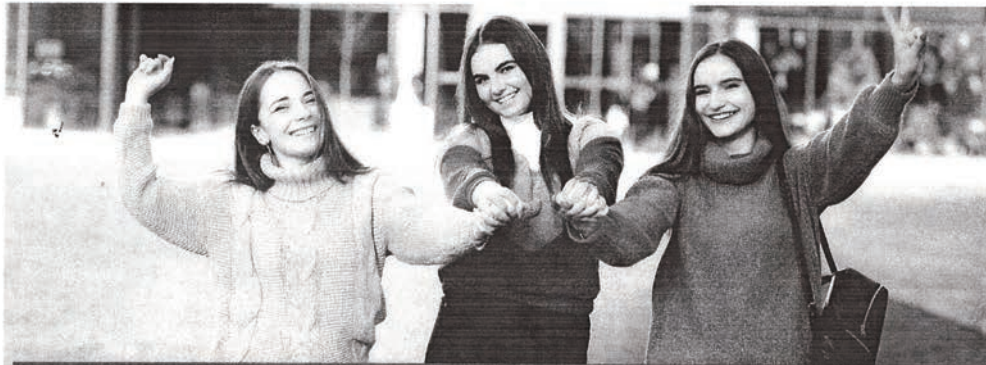

The loss of a child at any age...baby, young, teenage or adult is always the loss of a child. In most cases, it represents the parent's worst nightmare. After his own experience of losing his adult son, Dr. Bill very soon found people saying, "Let the healing begin".
