a. Minutes were submitted to the Church Secretary on Thursday, however, they were not received. a) Building Updates:

Peter and Fred met with the Architect in August (at no cost) to obtain some opinions regarding the demolition. Discussion with the Architect was regarding adding a new structure to house offices and a washroom or to work within the closed wall. The addition would be approximately 1400 sq/ft at a cost of \$400 per s/ft. The new addition would cost approximately \$560,000 – to put up the wall and renovate the space to include washroom, stairwell and offices would cost \$420,000. The building committee will meet and decide on which direction they will go.

Fred advised that we cannot put the offices in the basement as we will still require that for other functions. It was discussed that the north and south wings could possibly be turned into offices and still have seating above them with Fr.'s office being behind the sacristy.
