d. Eparchial Final Appeal: report submitted by Doreen Rathgeber

The Eparchial Appeal was closed on August 31, 2015. As you read in the August 30th bulletin, St. Mary's parishioners contributed \$22,500.00. The goal for St. Mary's was \$26, 675.00. The shortfall is \$4,175.00. Considering our late start and reluctance to move forward on this important appeal, we have done reasonably well. A weekly average of 170 offertory envelopes are received each week. There were 120 families who contributed to the Eparchial Appeal. If the 50 families who usually contribute to the Sunday offertory gave less than \$100.00 each, the goal would have been reached. By year end 450 families, one way or another, contribute to the parish. Our parish roster has a membership of 800 people. This information gives a snapshot of the financial support the parish receives from our parishioners.

e. Habitat for Humanity - Faith Build: report submitted by Gwen Bilyk

September 4th was a celebration for our Faith Group as we took part in the sod turning event along with Yorkton Habitat to mark the beginning of the building of our duplex. On August 27th we presented Tom Seeley with a cheque for \$35,558.83 that Prairie Harvest Christian Life Centre was holding in trust for the Faith Build. This cheque along with \$13,000.00 that was on account with Regina Habitat brings our fundraising to approx \$46,558.00. Donations came from various churches involved in the Faith Build who participated in fund raising on this as well from our musical production in April 2014. Our UCWLC made a significant donation, as well as some private donations from members in the Parish who wish to remain anonymous.
