Hopefully you took advantage of this warm respite and accom- PASTOR'S DESK plished things around the house and garden which can not be done in the winter.



We realize that in a matter of seven weeks we will joyously be celebrating the birth of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. The Church wisely reminds us to prepare spiritually for this momentous event by offering us the holy pre-Christmas season of "Pylypivka", the equivalent of the Roman Catholic Advent. This six week preparation commences the day after St. Philip the Apostle's Feast on November 14 - which is todav November 15th.

We, older people, remember this FAST once had very strict rules, much like Lent. Nowadays the Church still encourages us to prepare for the joy of Christmas by fasting, and increasing our acts of love and compassion. It is important to approach the fasting with the right attitude for remember – fasting involves not just food, but the entire being. Our *mouths* should fast from off-colour, offensive or hurtful words. Our eves should fast from things they shouldn't see, perhaps movies or television programs that do not promote Christian values. Our **ears** should fast from listening to things they shouldn't, like gossip and music that goes against moral integrity. Our *minds* should fast from thoughts that aren't compatible with life as Christians. Thus we would be wonderfully and spiritually preparing for a meaningful celebration of Jesus' birth.

We truly are so very blessed here in St. Mary's to have Father Delaere Council consisting of a number of our young and old parishioners who so actively strengthen our parish community. They have raised 1000's of \$ for so many charitable causes and devoted 100's of hours in volunteering their time and talent. As Pastor, I am so grateful to each and everyone and I strongly endorse Sunday, November 22nd as K of C membership drive. We want more young men to join the millions of Catholics who are so actively making a world of difference – here and now!

Yes, I have written this before I left for my 'sanity break' – so I might be a 'little off' on some of the events that have transpired in my absence – or whoops! Did you know I was gone for a couple of weeks? Do say 'yes' and I will feel much more welcome....





How Many Days Till Christmas?

This will be asked many times in the coming weeks. But will this guestion cause us to think about preparing fro the HOLIDAY SEASON or the HOLY DAY, CHRISTMAS? In all the rushing around, it is easy to forget that Jesus is the reason for the season. This is why the Church provides us with the time of the PRE-CHRISTMAS FAST, PYLYPIVKA sometimes called ADVENT, which begins on November 15 in our Ukrainian Catholic Church.

This period of preparation is a time of expectation, a time to ready our hearts for celebrating the presence of the Lord in the child born in Bethlehem. Society tells us to prepare and expect for another reason. The parking lots at the malls will be full, there will be more traffic on the roads, and checkout lines will be busier. The world begins to prepare early and we are touched by it. Our preparation, however, should include reflection on the rich mercy of our God who shares His only Son with us.
