

Beloved Parishioners and Guests,

Glory be to Jesus Christ! Glory be forever!

There was once a man who had four sons. He wanted his sons to learn not to judge things too quickly and so he sent them each on a quest, to go and look at a pear tree that was a great distance away.

The first son went in the winter, the second in the spring. the third in the summer and the youngest in the fall. When they PASTOR'S DESK had all gone and returned he called them together to describe



what they had seen. The first son said that the tree was ugly, bent and twisted. The second son said that it was covered with green buds and full of promise. The third son disagreed: he said it was laden with blossoms that smelled so sweet and looked so beautiful that it was the most graceful thing he has ever seen. The last son disagreed with all of them; he said it was ripe and drooping with fruit, full of life and fulfillment.

The man explained to his sons that they were all right, because they had each only seen one season in the tree's life. He told them that you cannot judge a tree or a person by only one season. He told them that the essence of who they are and the pleasure, joy and love that come from that life can only be measured at the end, when all the seasons are done.

If you give up when it's winter, you will miss the promise of spring, the beauty of your summer and the fulfillment of your fall. Do not let the pain of one season destroy the joy of all the rest. Do not judge life by one difficult season. Persevere through the difficult patches and better times are sure to come.

Each of us, sooner or later, is one of the four sons. We pass judgment on what we seen and accept this as the overall truth without stopping to think that we have only seen a small part of the whole picture.

We do this so very often. If I, your pastor, were to put on some old dirty clothes and an old wrinkled hat and to come into church, many might turn their noses to me. They might feel that they are better than I and would not want their children sitting next to me. And yet, I would still be the same person to whom you show much respect as I walk in dressed in the black clothes that you often see on me. Yes, we all tend to base our prejudice on appearance and oh, how truly unfair this can be!

Perhaps if we could see ourselves in the role of the "pear tree" rather than one of the sons, we would posses a much better understanding of life. Perhaps we should ask ourselves a few very basic questions... "How would WE want to be judged? Would WE want to be judged by how some one sees us at a given moment in time? Or would WE want to be judged by the mistakes that we have made throughout our lives?... No matter who we are, we all deserve to be seen through all of the seasons of our lifetime!

May our "roles" of both the "sons" and the "tree" lead us to embrace generosity, compassion and kindness - especially as we spiritually prepare for the celebration of Our Lord's Resurrection!

Був собі раз чоловік і мав він четверо синів. Він хотів їх навчити нікого не осуджувати і вислав їх їд пошуки пригод та сказав оглянути грушу, яка росла далеко від них.

Перший син вибрався зимою, другий на весну, третій літом а наймолодший в осені. Коли вони вже всі це дерево добре оглянули та повернулися дойіїю, він покликав їх до себе, щоб вони розповіли йому, що вони бачили. Перший син сказав, що дерево огидне, схилене та скручене. Другий сказав, що воно покрите зеленими бруньками та є повне надії. Третій не згідний з братами, сказав, що дерево покрите квітом та пахне і виглядає так чудово, що воно є найкраще дерево, яке він будь-коли бачив. А останній син не годився з жодним із них. Кожний із нас скорше чи пізніше є одним із чотирьох синів. Ми осуджуємо то, що ми за один раз бачимо і приймаємо це, як правду, не застановляючись над тим, що ми бачили лиш маленьку частину цілої картини.

Ми це робимо часто. Якщо я, ваш парох, прийшов би до церкви в старім, подертім одягу і в помнятій шапці, багато із вас відвернули б від мене голову. Ви би уважали себе кращими за мене і не хотіли б, щоб ваші діти коло мене сідали. Але я був би тою самою людиною, якій ви показуєте повагу, коли я приходжу одягнений в чорнім опягу, до якого ви так звикли. Так, ми всі часто судимо людей по зовнішньому вигляді а це дуже не справедливо!

Може, якщо би ми побачили себе в ролі дерева а не одного зі синів, ми би краще зрозоміли життя. І при тій нагоді, може ми повинні спитати себе кілька дуже основних питань... Як би ми хотіли, щоб НАС судили? Чи ми хотіли б, щоб нас судили після того, як нас бачили в лиш один даний час? Або, чи ми хотіли б, щоб нас судили після помилок, які ми за своє життя зробили? Без огялду на то, хто ми є, всі ми гідні того, щоб нас бачити з перспективи всіх пір нашого життя.

Нехай наші **ролі**, як *синів* так і *дерева*, спонукають нас справедливо пілходити до свого довкілля та обдаровувати всіх щедрістю і любо'ю!
