

#### Beloved Parishioners and Guests.

A couple of interesting questions popped up in the past couple of weeks: "Why do we do what we do in church? Is there a special meaning for the lit candles and even for the incense that you often use during our religious services?" Why not share a little history and explain some can traditions, especially since incense is used so often during PASTOR'S DESK



#### "A Pleasing Fragrance for the Lord"

Jesus tells us in the Gospel: "Every generous act of giving, with every perfect gift, is from above, coming down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shadow due to change" Gift and light. Incense and candles. Prayer and honour.

The most costly and valued incense traditionally is made from the resins of particular trees. Fragrant smoke is produced by burning it on hot coals. Burning incense as perfume was common in the ancient Near East.

Eventually, incense came to be used in pagan worship, and naturally found its way into the worship of Israelites. During worship in the Jerusalem Temple, it was often burned together with the animal sacrifices as a secondary offer to God. It was also burned as a separate offering on a golden altar in the Temple.

The Church gradually adopted the use of incense within the Divine Liturgy, reminding all the worshippers that their prayer and petitions should "rise like the smoke" of the incense to heaven. In the Pre-Sanctified Lenten Liturgy, we often sing this hymn: "Let my prayer rise like incense before You, and the lifting of my hands, like an evening sacrifice."

Candles also date back to the ancient Near East. Pagan rites involving the lighting of candles or lamps as a sign of honour for their idols, their rules and their beloved dead.

Jews light candles or lamps during their Passover Seder meal, and at their weekly Sabbath meal. Hanukkah, celebrated with the lighting of the Menorah, is often called the Feast of Lights. Light versus darkness is an obvious and recurring theme throughout the Scriptures.

The first use of candles or lamps in **Christian worship** dates back to the 2<sup>nd</sup> century with Lucernare (meaning 'light'), an evening prayer service that evolved into **Vespers**. Candles were often used in religious processions and placed on the holy altar.

Incense and candles have many levels of meaning. "Gift" and "Light", they appeal to our senses, helping us to enter more fully into prayer and honour. They remind us that the "offering" of our lives at Liturgy are joined with Christ's selfoffering. They help us recall God's presence among us, so that, God willing, Jesus never has to say of us: "This people honour me with their lips, but their hearts are far from Me."



#### About the film:

**MYTH** is the life story of Wassyl "Myth" Slipak, an opera singer with a worldwide reputation and a unique voice. Following his dreams, Wassyl lived and performed in France for 19 years and had everything he could want for happiness: he was famous and respected in the opera world, he had a network of dear friends and supporters, and he had found the love of his life.

Following Revolution of Dignity/Euromaidan, Wassyl led demonstrations and the volunteer movement in France. It would seem he had done enough, but he decided to leave his life in France and join the ranks of frontline volunteers when war came to his native Ukraine. Wassyl died from a sniper's bullet during the execution of a combat mission, but his story has continued to echo across Ukraine and the rest of the globe.

#### About our event:

With the gracious assistance of the Yorkton Film Festival, the Ukrainian Canadian Congress – Yorkton Branch is excited to host this documentary in our city. We are proud to be one of only three Saskatchewan stops on Myth's North American tour. We will provide a screening evening on March 16th, followed by a Q&A session with both the documentary's directors as well as the brother of Wassyl Slipak.

#### All donations collected will be forwarded on to Dopomoha Ukraini-Aid Ukraine

Dopomoha Ukraini - Aid Ukraine (CRA Registration no.: 891205940RR0001) is a Canadian charity that works to provide humanitarian and social aid to Ukraine and promote Ukrainian culture in Canada. Originally established in 1993, Dopomoha Ukraini renewed full-scale activities in 2013 in response to the new challenges posed by the Euromaidan and the ongoing war in eastern Ukraine with Russia and Russian-backed separatist troops.

Their present projects include the ATO Widows Rehabilitation and PTSD Program (in response to the War with Russia, a program jointly run by the Canada Ukraine Foundation, Dopomoha Ukraini, and the New Generational International Charitable Fund in Kyiv), the Anti-Trafficking Initiative (combating human trafficking), and more.
