

Dear Parishioners of St. Mary's and our Guests,

Would you believe that we have almost finished our various organizational meetings? What will I do with my time and energy?



Every once in a while we come across a most delightful and insightful story that gives us a better understanding of love and life. The following truly is one to cherish:

"One day a small opening appeared in a cocoon. A man sat and watched for the butterfly for several hours as it struggled to force its body through that little hole. Then it seemed to stop making any progress. It appeared as if it had gotten as far as it could and it could not go any further.

"So the man decided to help the butterfly; he took a pair of scissors and opened the cocoon. The butterfly then emerged easily. But it had a withered body and it was tiny and had shrivelled wings.

"The man continued to watch because he expected that at any moment the wings would open, enlarge and expand to be able to support the butterfly's body and become firm. Neither happened. In fact the butterfly spent the rest of its life crawling around with a withered body and shrivelled wings. It never was able to fly.

"What the man in his kindness and his good will did not understand was that the restricting cocoon and the struggle required for the butterfly to get through the tiny opening were nature's way of forcing fluid from the body of the butterfly into its wings so that it would be ready for flight once it achieved its freedom from the cocoon."

Sometimes struggles and hardships are exactly what we need in our life! If we were allowed to go through our life without any obstacles, it would cripple us! We would not be as strong as we could be - never be able to fly!!! All of us can think of expressive examples of "failures" that were the road to success... I know I can touch upon many such examples... think about it! "Failures" have not been necessarily Stop signs, but truly proved to be a re-direction to our lives and dreams.

Jesus was the perfect failure – He was horribly crucified, He painfully died and was sadly buried - but then we know He arose, He resurrected and promised all of us who dare to strongly believe in Him, live like Him and die for one another, that we would resurrection to Life Everlasting! Wow!


