Dear Beloved Parishioners and Guests,

Tis good to be in touch with you via my bulletin message. At times I can share some good news and sometimes bad news, or share some delightful tid-bits, interesting and challenging stories, or just some personal and parish items that we must be aware of... The following is a little shocking and assumedly disturbing...



FROM THE Pastor's Desi

Over the months and years we unfortunately have lost some of our loyal and generous parishioners – some have

moved away, some have stopped coming to church for reasons unknown, and some have been called into the Heavenly Kingdom. Nevertheless, the reality is: there are less and less faithful and loyal parishioners. Yes, this does bother me as your Pastor. I have visited a number of past parishioners and current parishioners to encourage more faithful church attendance and yes, even to hope that they will support our church personally and even financially...

The number of church envelopes has diminished drastically and yes, our finances are not in the most positive condition. e.g., our **Profit & Loss** statement for St. Mary's from January through August is a striking wake-up call – **Income:** \$161,310.08, **Expenses:** \$178,450.14 = **Net Income:** -\$17,140.06 which means we must dip into our **Savings** and obviously this is not healthy or a positive step...

Ironically, we have **737** members on our <u>parish list</u>, and yet only **324** have envelopes, **44 Associate** members and sadly 369 non-active members have not given a penny to support our church and possibly only come to church on Easter or Christmas. Over the 3 years I have visited most of them to bless their home and invite them to our parish, but obviously without much success. **Do we remove them from the parish list**, realizing many of them are **your** children or grandchildren? Could you please convince them to become active parishioners? Could you succeed where I have badly failed?

Many country parishes are now closed for lack of members and funds? How long can we in Yorkton expect to maintain St. Mary's with an **Annual Deficit**?

Please may we encourage you to be more generous to help alleviate this dire situation. When was the last time you gave your parish a **cost of living increase**?

Please consider signing up for our **PAG** (*Pre-Authorized Giving Plan*) to ensure a steady income for our parish throughout the year. To be honest, I am disappointed that so few have responded to this request. Please pray as a family - decide how you can help!

Some Christian churches use the "tithing" practice to support their church which is usually 10% of their income. Instead just imagine if every parishioner gave just the equivalent of *one hour's wage or salary(1/40)* – our Church Collection would triple and we thus would ensure the parish's positive future and its lasting stability! Think about it!

Yes, I do feel most awkward writing this but if I don't have the courage to question and challenge our parishioners, why am I here as your Pastor?

Forgive me, but please do think, pray and act upon this delicate topic!
