Glory be to Jesus Christ! Glory be forever!

Monday, March 4th, we begin the **Lenten season**, our preparation for the Holy Feast of the **Resurrection**. Jesus has very important advice for us as we commence this or any religious observance: "If you are bringing your offering to the altar, and there remember that your sister or brother has pastor's Desk something against you, leave your offering there before the



altar, go and be reconciled with your them first, and then come back and present your offering." Mt. 5:23

That is why we must try to right any relationship that has been impaired before engaging in any religious practice. Otherwise, our worship is not coming from a heart ready to do God's will and cannot be considered honest and sincere.


And so the day before the commencement of Great Fast is dedicated to the "righting" of our relationships in our day-to-day lives. It is known as Forgiveness Sunday, a sacred time during which we humbly ask forgiveness of those with whom we may be at odds - be it with family or friends or co-workers - that we may inadvertently have offended. The experience of asking forgiveness and of giving it helps purify our hearts and frees us to be more openly receptive to God and others, not just to ourselves, as we observe the religious customs of Lent (the Great Fast).

In church this reciprocal Forgiveness Rite takes place during the Vesper Service on Sunday evening. We. however, wish to celebrate this short meaningful service during next Sat/Sun's Divine Liturgies, and not at Vespers. It is so very important that all of us parishioners can more actively participate and that is most commendable - because we truly do form a parish family and we want all wounds and hurts to be put behind us so that, as renewed and forgiven sisters and brothers in Christ, we can sincerely begin our spiritual journey to Easter - Christ's Holy Resurrection.

In this ritual be prepared to ask forgiveness of one another and exchange the kiss of peace. This holy practice may certainly be encouraged in the home as well. Sadly we often take our relationships at home for granted. Living together in close quarters requires a lot of patience, sensitivity and sacrifice but some times we do not fully respect one another as we should. In fact, at times it is at home where the greatest offenses take place, simply because it is in the home that we are most frequently our true selves.

In truth, children need to witness their parents asking forgiveness of one another and of them also. Parents set the example and show that love always means having to say "I'm sorry". When "asking forgiveness" is practiced regularly at home, children learn that everyone can fail at one time or another, but God in His great love and forgiveness for us has shown us the best way out of our failures.

May this Lent be a wonderful joyful and life-giving journey!

Glory be to Jesus Christ!

The Catholic Bishops of Saskatchewan have initiated a public campaign to encourage our Provincial Government to enact legislation to protect the conscience rights of health care professionals. The public Call for Conscience campaign will include education and action components. On Sunday, February 24th, we would like all parishes to screen a video and invite parishioners to send letters to the Ministers of Health, the Premier and the Leader of the Opposition. Parishioners can sign the letter electronically at https://www.canadiansforconscience.ca/saskatchewan or parishes can provide printed copies to be signed at Sunday Divine Liturgies on February 24.

This campaign is prepared in cooperation with the Coalition for HealthCare and Conscience, a national coalition of churches, healthcare facilities and medical professionals. There is also an ecumenical team working to coordinate the Call for Conscience campaign in other churches across Saskatchewan. The Call for Conscience campaign addresses the lack of legal protection for healthcare professional who cannot participate in Assisted Suicide or Euthanasia as a matter of conscience. In Canada, assisted suicide was legalized by the Supreme Court and federal Parliament, but medical professions are a matter of provincial jurisdictions. As such, specific legal protections still need to be established to protect healthcare professionals.

Opinion polls indicate that even among those who support assisted suicide there is a 60% approval for conscience protection. However, some provincial regulatory bodies are moving to restrict conscience rights and require participation by doctors, nursers, pharmacists and others who work with vulnerable patients. We are calling upon our provincial government to enact clear protections for these healthcare professionals in matters of conscience.

Your active support and cooperation in this matter is greatly appreciated as we must not remain silent on this issue which is a direct threat to our fundamental freedoms of conscience in this country.
